Excellency,

As a follow-up to the letter of the president of the General Assembly, dated 24 March 2006, updating Member States on the status of the United Nations reform process in different areas, we are pleased to convey to you the following information in our capacity as Co-Chairs for the consultations of the General Assembly on a comprehensive UN counter-terrorism strategy:

- 1. The Secretary-General will present to the General Assembly Plenary proposals in regard to the forthcoming work of the General Assembly on a comprehensive UN counter-terrorism strategy on 2 May (morning).
- 2. The first informal consultations of the General Assembly Plenary on this subject will be held on 11 May (morning and afternoon) and, if necessary, on 12 May (morning). The meeting(s) will provide an opportunity for Member States to make their general comments, in particular on the proposals and inputs of the Secretary-General.
- 3. Informal consultations of the General Assembly Plenary on this subject will continue on 15 (afternoon), 16 (morning) and 17 May (morning) to allow for more focused discussions.
- 4. We will inform you immediately after these informal consultations on the steps ahead and the precise timetable thereon.

We look forward to receiving your support and cooperation during our consultations, so as to ensure the adoption and implementation of an efficient comprehensive UN counter-terrorism strategy, as agreed by our Heads of State and Government in the Outcome Document of the High-Level Plenary meeting of the General Assembly in September 2005.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of our highest consideration.
