
We are writing with reference to General Assembly resolution 68/6 entitled "Outcome document of the Special Event to follow-up on efforts made toward achieving the Millennium Development Goals", in which the General Assembly requested the President of the General Assembly to convene, in a timely manner, intergovernmental consultations to achieve agreement on the organizational modalities for the summit that will take place in September 2015 at the level of Heads of State and Government for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda.
