Recalling operative paragraph 248 of the outcome document of the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development, entitled "The future we want", contained in resolution 66/288 of 11 September 2012, detailing the intergovernmental process of the General Assembly on sustainable development goals, with a view to developing global sustainable development goals to be agreed by the General Assembly,

Takes note of the report of the Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals circulated in document A/68/970 for further consideration and appropriate action by the General Assembly on the proposal contained in that report in the context of the Inter-governmental negotiation process on the post-2015 Development Agenda at its sixty-ninth session.
