Draft resolution submitted by the President of the General Assembly

Report of the Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals established pursuant to General Assembly resolution 66/288

The General Assembly,

Recalling the outcome document of the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development, entitled "The future we want", contained in resolution 66/288 of 11 September 2012, which, inter alia, resolved to establish an inclusive and transparent intergovernmental process on sustainable development goals open to all stakeholders, with a view to developing global sustainable development goals to be agreed by the General Assembly,

- 1. Acknowledges the conclusion of the work of the Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals, and welcomes its report issued as document A/68/970<sup>1</sup>,
- 2. Decides that the proposal of the Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals contained in the report shall be the basis for integrating sustainable development goals into the post-2015 development agenda, while recognizing fully that other inputs may also be considered in this intergovernmental negotiation process at the sixty-ninth session of the General Assembly.

Reservations by Member States to the report of the Open Working Group on Sustainable Development Goals are referenced in paragraph 13 of document Λ/68/970.
