

## GRENADA NATIONAL ACTION PLAN

### FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SECURITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 1540 (2004)

Grenada is not a country that produces or deals with the type of material that is sensitive in terms of proliferation and the general threat that UNSCR 1540 (2004) purports to address. However, the country and the general region is an important and relevant shipment and transshipment hub, and witnesses substantial movement of trade and personnel. To that extent, it is important for the country to adopt a robust legal framework and implement other measures that contribute towards more effective observance to UNSCR 1540 (2004). In this regard, within the context of the work conducted to date with the 1540 Committee and its experts, CARICOM AND UNLIREC, the Government of Grenada has drafted this voluntary action plan for strengthening its implementation of Resolution 1540 (2004).

#### Key Proposals

The primary purpose of the National Action Plan is to identify actions that can be taken to enhance the capacity of the Government of Grenada to implement UN resolution 1540 (2004). The actions are proposed on three levels:

**Level 1** - Actions that the Government of Grenada may take immediately in the near term with no, or very limited, external support

**Level 2** - Actions that the Government of Grenada may undertake with the support of UNLIREC as part of Phase 1 of its 1540 technical assistance package

**Level 3** - Actions that have been identified under medium- long term objectives which may require additional mobilization of resources for their implementation as well as other partners.
