Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic

Decision No. 340 of 24 December 2021 to approve the Action Plan of the Kyrgyz Republic for the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) for the period 2022–2025

With a view to ensuring the effective implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) and resolution 1977 (2011), and in accordance with articles 13 and 17 of the Constitutional Act of the Kyrgyz Republic on the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic, the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic hereby decides to:

1. Approve the Action Plan of the Kyrgyz Republic for the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) for the period 2022–2025 (hereinafter, “the Action Plan”), as set out in the annex hereto.
2. Direct ministries, the State Committee, administrative agencies and other government bodies to:
 - Take every measure to implement the Action Plan in a timely manner.
 - Submit, at the half-year and end-of-year marks, no later than on the fifteenth day of the month following the reporting period, information on the implementation of the Action Plan to the Ministry of Economy and Commerce of the Kyrgyz Republic for compilation.
3. The Ministry of Economy and Commerce of the Kyrgyz Republic shall, no later than the twenty-fifth day of the month following the reporting period, provide to the Office of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic a compilation of the information received on the implementation of the Action Plan.
4. Establish the personal responsibility of the heads of the State executive bodies of the Kyrgyz Republic for the quality and timely implementation of the Action Plan.
5. Direct the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic to notify the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution 1540 (2004) of the approval of the Action Plan.
6. Repeal Government Decision No. 443 of 24 July 2017 on the approval of the Action Plan of the Kyrgyz Republic for the implementation of Security Council resolution 1540 (2004) for the period 2017–2019.

7. Entrust the oversight of the implementation of the present Decision to the department overseeing the implementation of decisions of the President and the Cabinet of Ministers of the Office of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic.

8. The present Decision shall enter into force within 10 days of the date of official publication.
