Royal Resolution of 28 October 1932 covering the Customs Law of 22 June 1928

Pursuant to section 3 of the above-mentioned law it is decreed that the statutory provisions concerning the customs inspection of vessels and concerning the loading and unloading of goods from or consigned to foreign countries and the dispatch of goods within the realm shall be applicable within a boundary lying ten nautical miles out to sea from the outermost islands and islets that are not continually swept over by the sea.
