**United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea  
concluded at Montego Bay, Jamaica  
on 10 December 1982**

Receipt of an amendment to the submission made by  
the People's Republic of Bangladesh to the Commission on the Limits of the  
Continental Shelf

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following:

On 25 February 2011, the People's Republic of Bangladesh submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with Article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea is measured.

On 22 October 2020, the People's Republic of Bangladesh submitted an amendment to its submission, which according to the coastal State supersedes in its entirety the original submission made on 25 February 2011.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission (CLCS/40/Rev.1), the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the amended executive summary of the submission, including all charts and coordinates contained therein, which is available on the website of the Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea, Office of Legal Affairs, at: [www.un.org/Depts/los](http://www.un.org/Depts/los).
