**United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea
Montego Bay, 10 December 1982**

Receipt of an amended executive summary of the Submission made by Cuba to the
Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf
in respect of the eastern polygon in the Gulf of Mexico

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following:

On 1 June 2009, Cuba submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, information on the limits of its continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of its territorial sea is measured in respect of the eastern polygon in the Gulf of Mexico.

On 15 February 2024, Cuba submitted an amended executive summary which, according to the coastal State, supersedes the original executive summary of its Submission made on 1 June 2009.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission (CLCS/40/Rev.1), the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the amended executive summary of the Submission, including all charts and coordinates contained therein, which is available on the website of the Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea, Office of Legal Affairs, at: www.un.org/Depts/los.
