Receipt of the submission made by the Republic of Liberia
to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following

On 23 October 2018, the Republic of Liberia submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of its territorial sea is measured.

It is noted that the Convention entered into force for the Republic of Liberia on 25 October 2008

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission (CLCS/40/Rev.1), the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the executive summary of the submission, including all charts and coordinates contained therein. The executive summary of the submission is available on the website of the Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea, Office of Legal Affairs, at www.un.org/Depts/los.

The consideration of the submission made by the Republic of Liberia will be included in the provisional agenda of the forty-ninth session of the Commission scheduled to be held in New York from 28 January to 15 March 2019.

Upon completion of the consideration of the submission, the Commission will issue recommendations pursuant to article 76 of the Convention.
