## United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea Montego Bay, 10 December 1982

Receipt of an addendum to the Submission made by Mexico in respect of the eastern polygon in the Gulf of Mexico to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following:

On 19 December 2011, Mexico submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea is measured in respect of the eastern polygon in the Gulf of Mexico.

On 30 June 2025, Mexico submitted an addendum to the Submission.

In accordance with the rules of procedure of the Commission (CLCS/40/Rev.2), the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the executive summary of the addendum to the Submission, including all illustrative maps and lists of geographical coordinates of points contained therein.
