Receipt of Amended Executive Summary and Addendum to the Submission
made by the Portuguese Republic to the Commission on the Limits of
the Continental Shelf

The Secretary-General of the United Nations communicates the following:

On 11 May 2009, the Portuguese Republic submitted to the Commission on the Limits of the Continental Shelf, in accordance with Article 76, paragraph 8, of the Convention, information on the limits of the continental shelf beyond 200 nautical miles from the baselines from which the breadth of the territorial sea is measured.

On 1 August 2017, the Portuguese Republic submitted an addendum to the submission, which according to the coastal State replaced the entire submission made by the Portuguese Republic on 11 May 2009.

On 22 August 2017, the Portuguese Republic also submitted an amended executive summary to its submission.

In accordance with the Rules of Procedure of the Commission (CLCS/40/Rev. 1), as well as the decision of the Commission taken at its sixteenth session (CLCS/48, paragraphs 18 and 19), the present communication is being circulated to all Member States of the United Nations, as well as States Parties to the Convention, in order to make public the amended executive summary, including all charts and coordinates contained therein, which is available on the website of the Division for Ocean Affairs and the Law of the Sea, Office of Legal Affairs, at: www.un.org/Depts/los.
