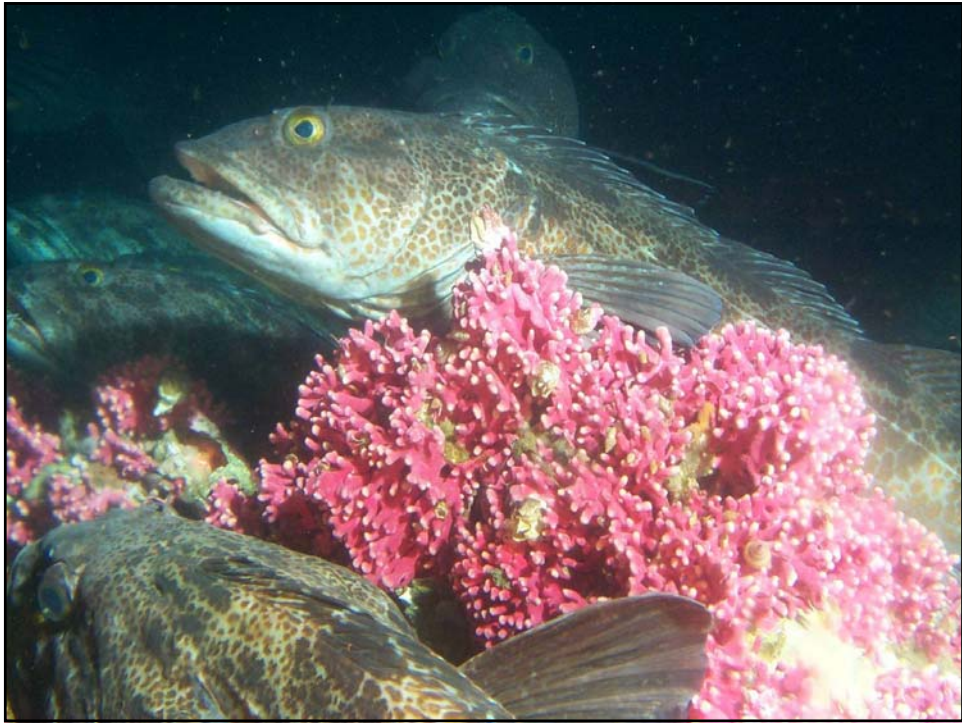




The problems of ocean space are closely interrelated and need to be considered as a whole. (Preamble to the UN Convention on the Law of the Sea, 1982)
