Total Oil Revenue

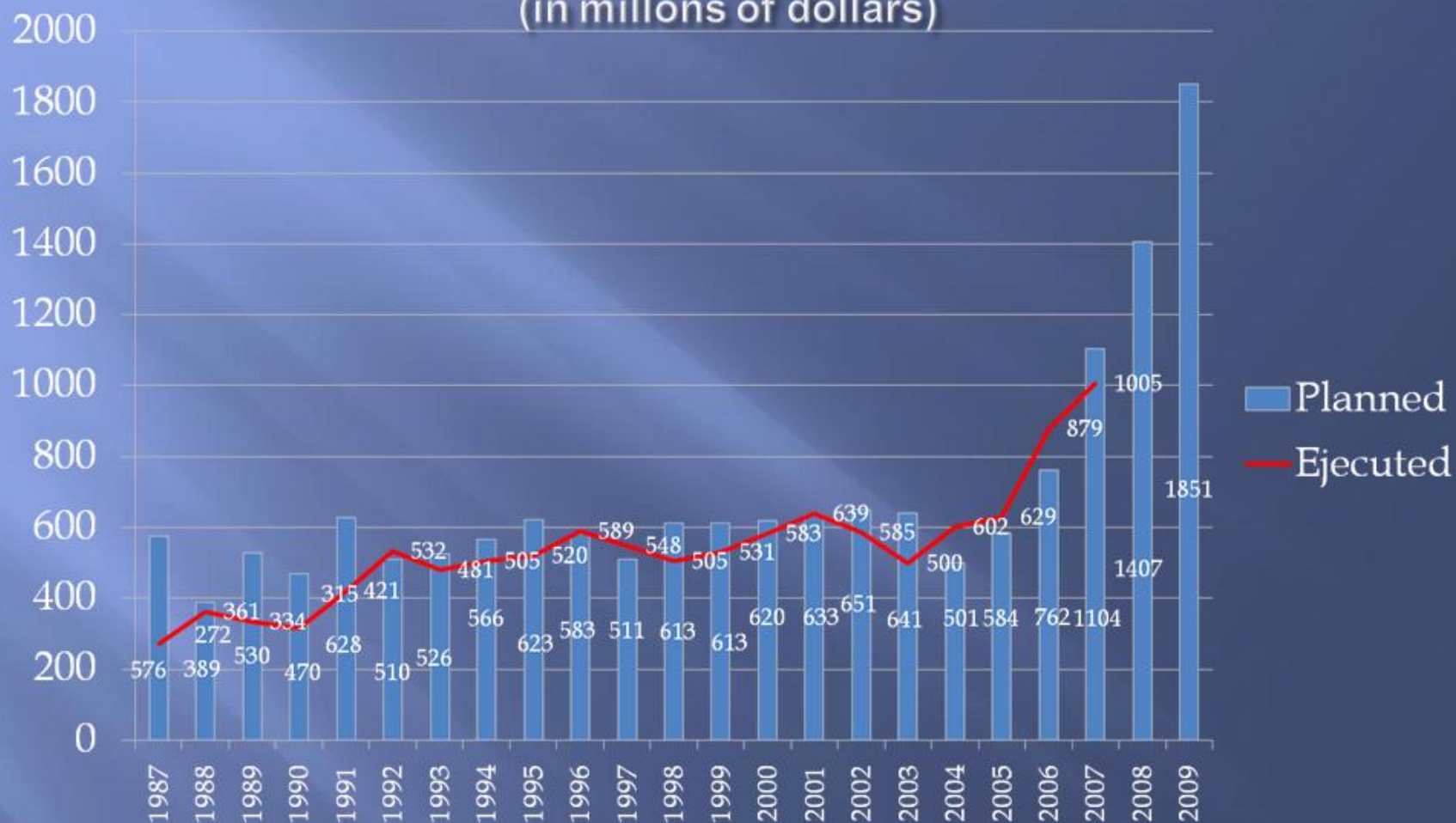

(in millions of dollars)

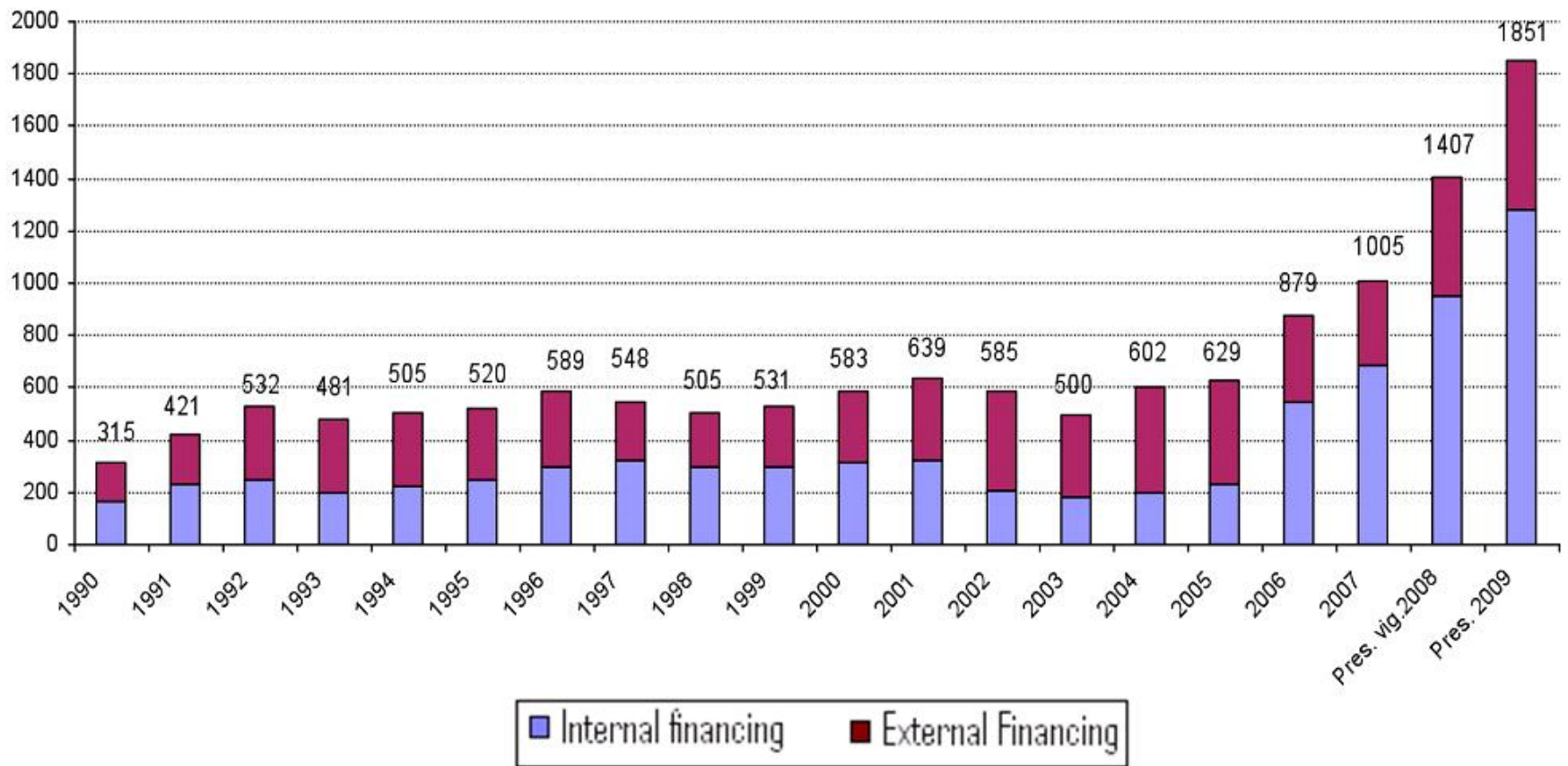

Financing source of Public investment 1990 -2009

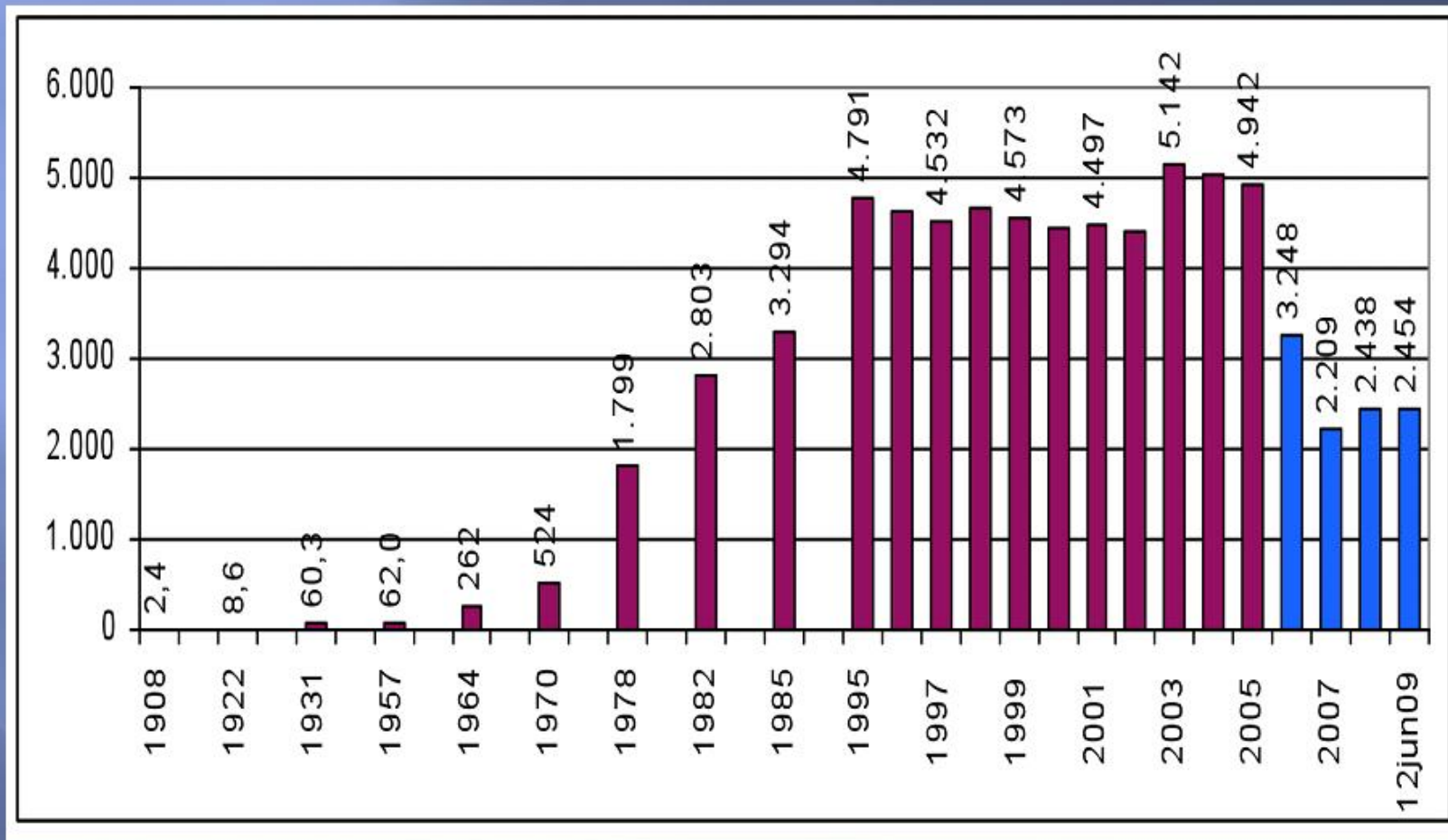

(in millions of dollars)

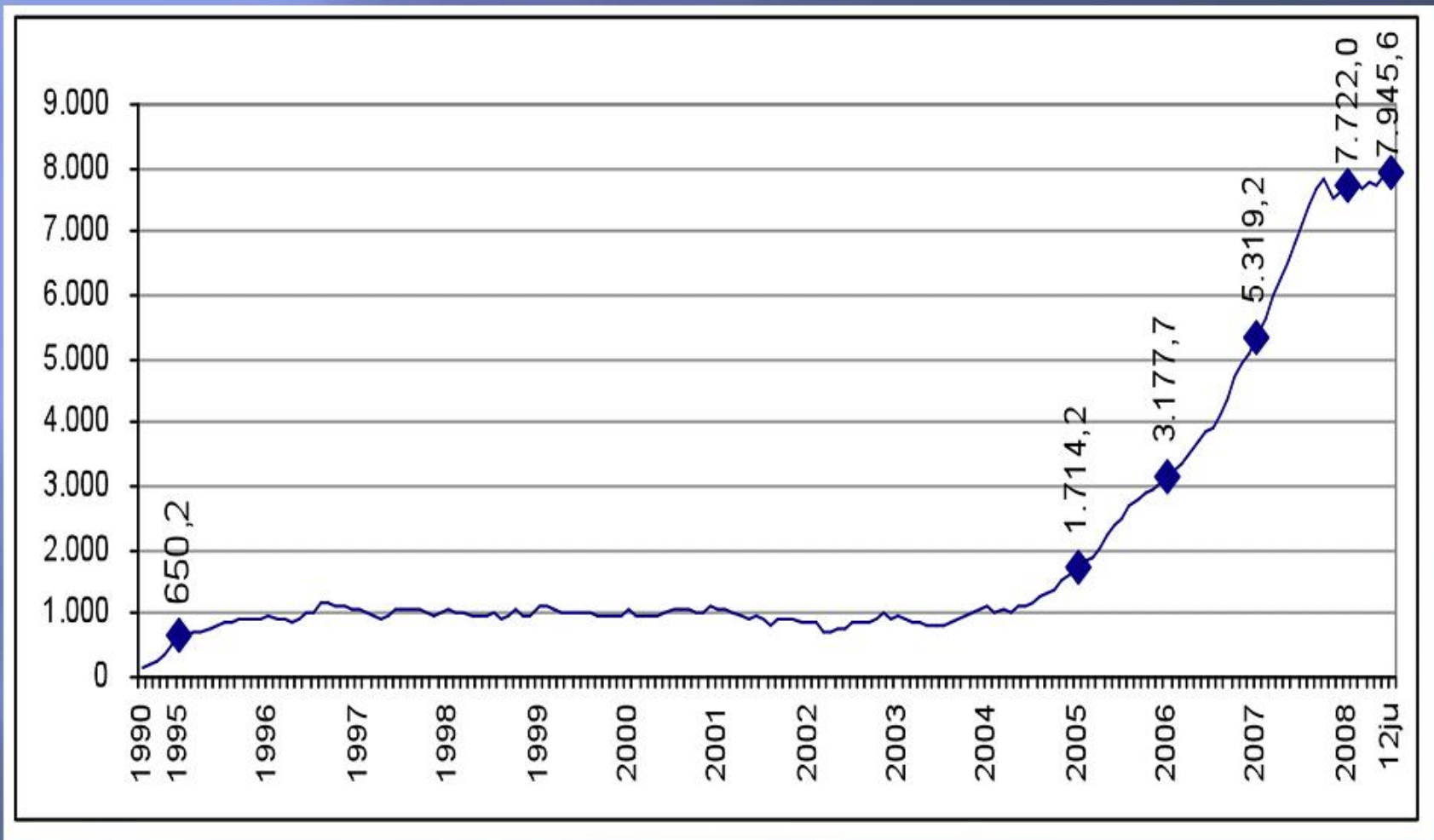

(in millions of dollars)

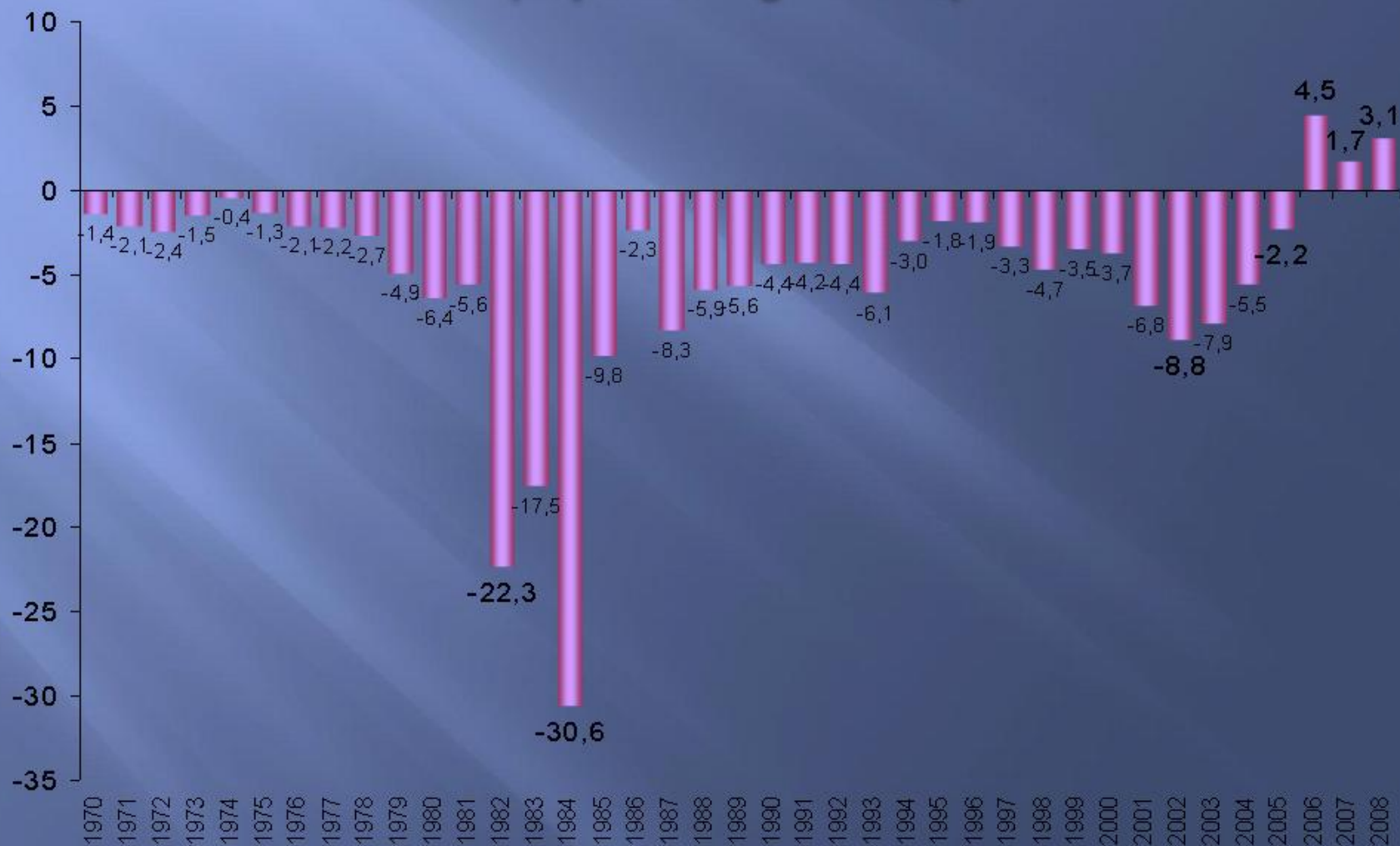

(in percentage of PIB)

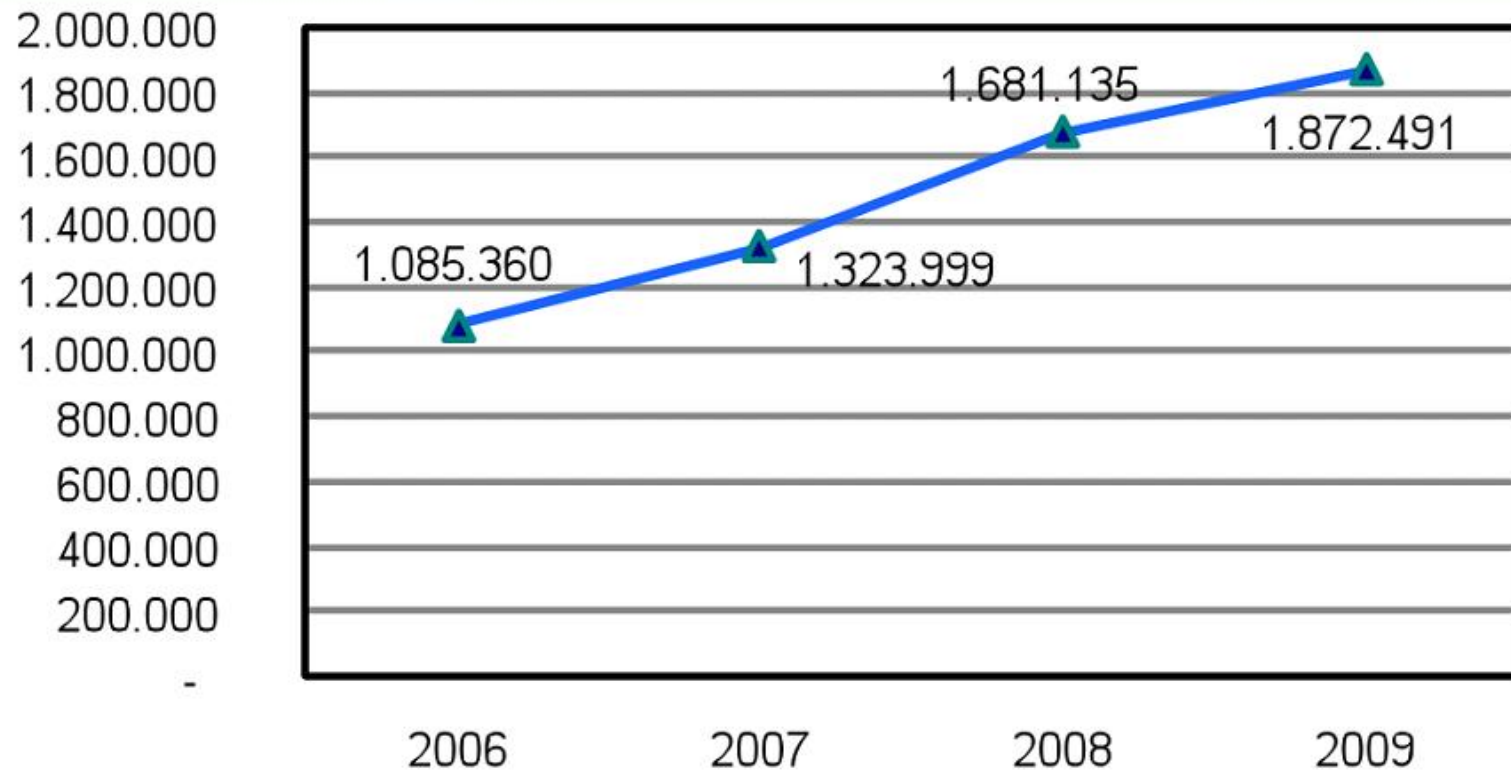

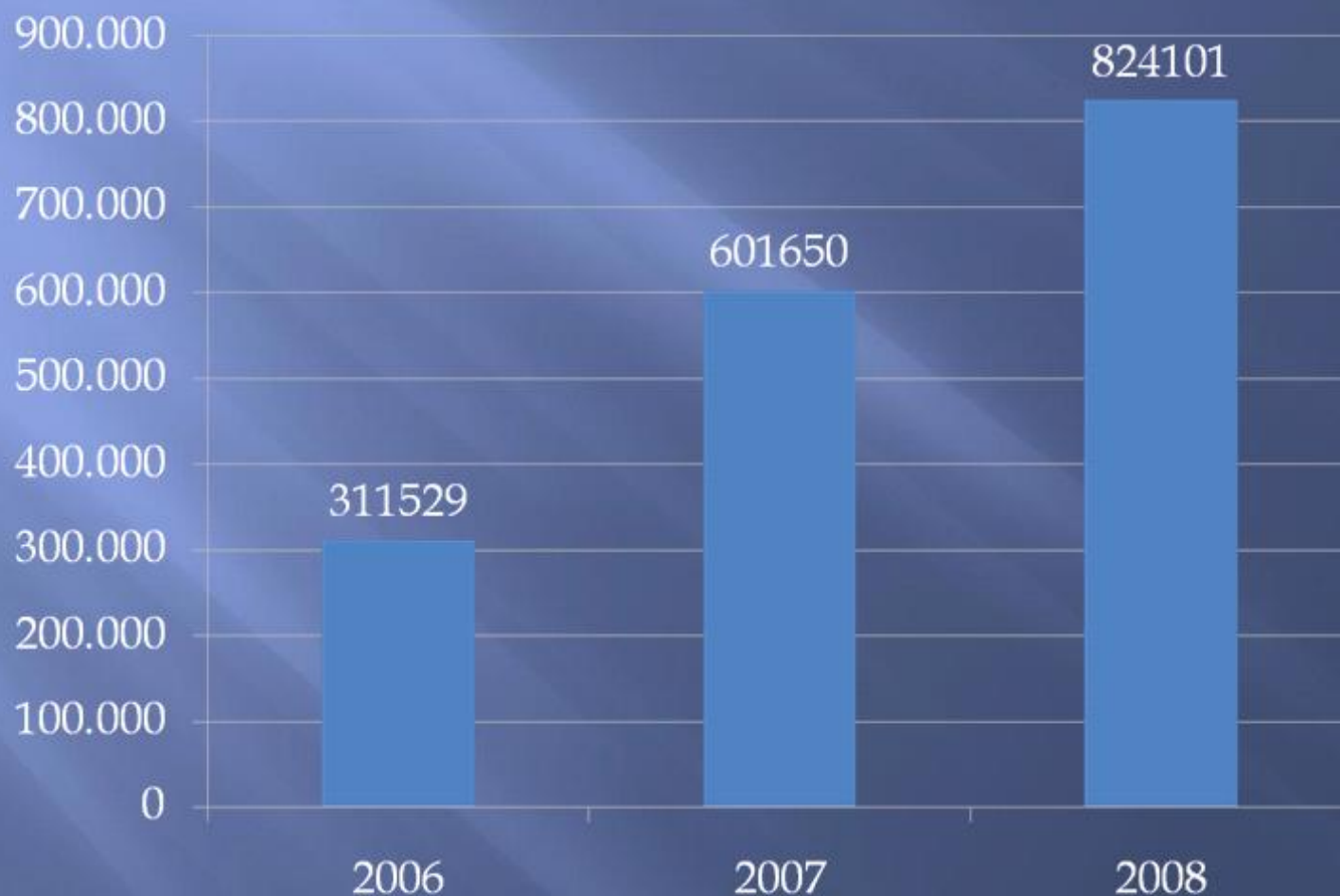

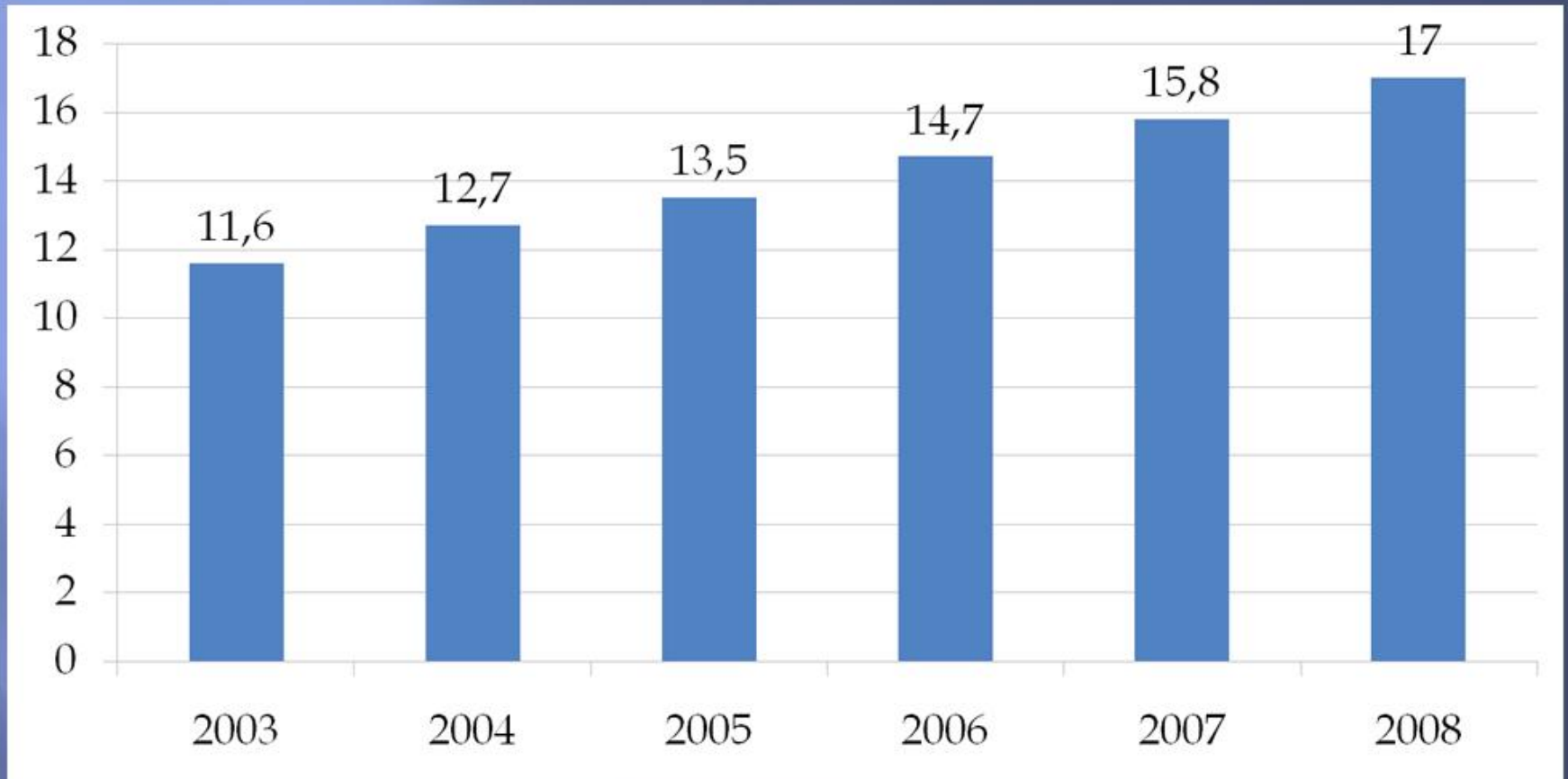

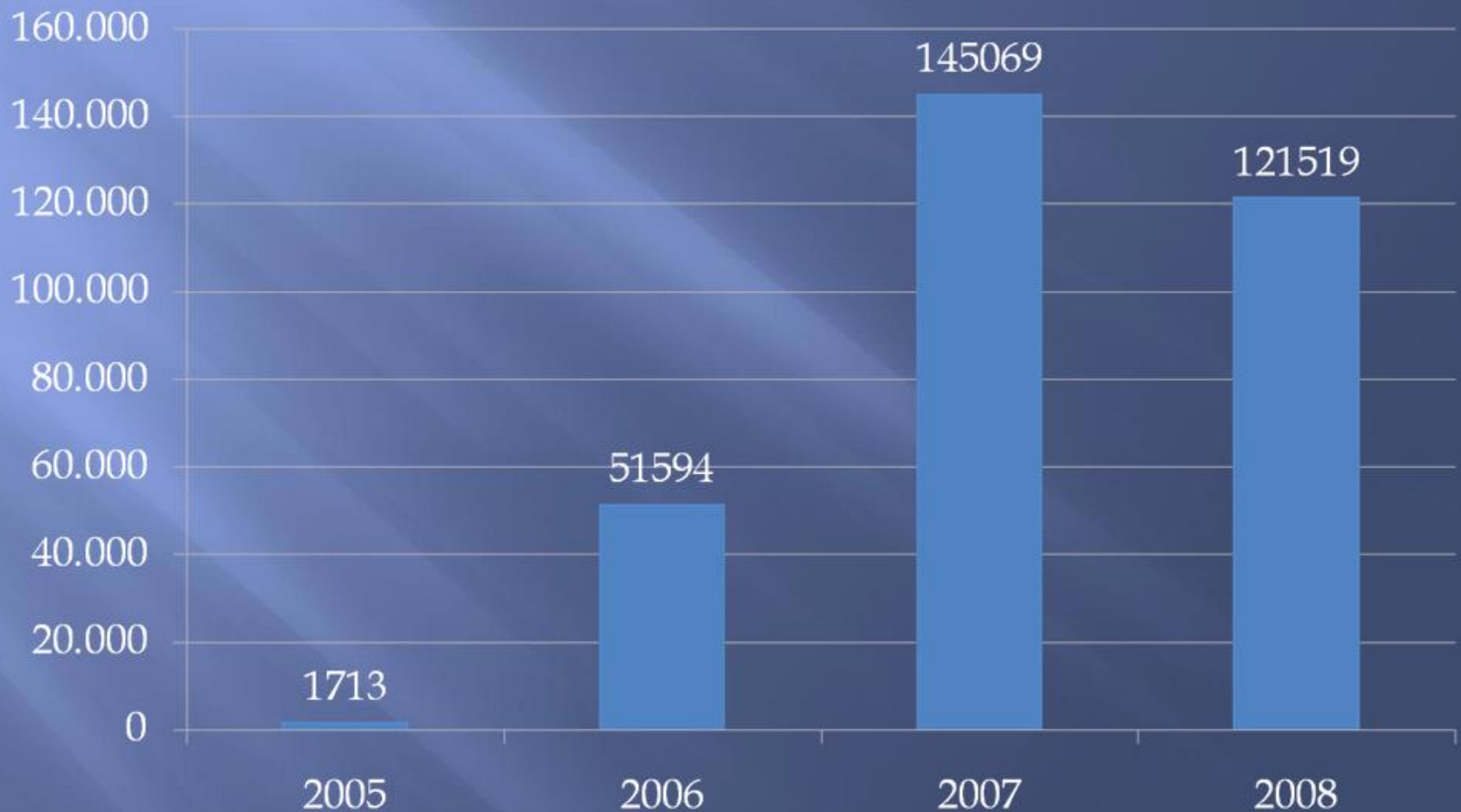

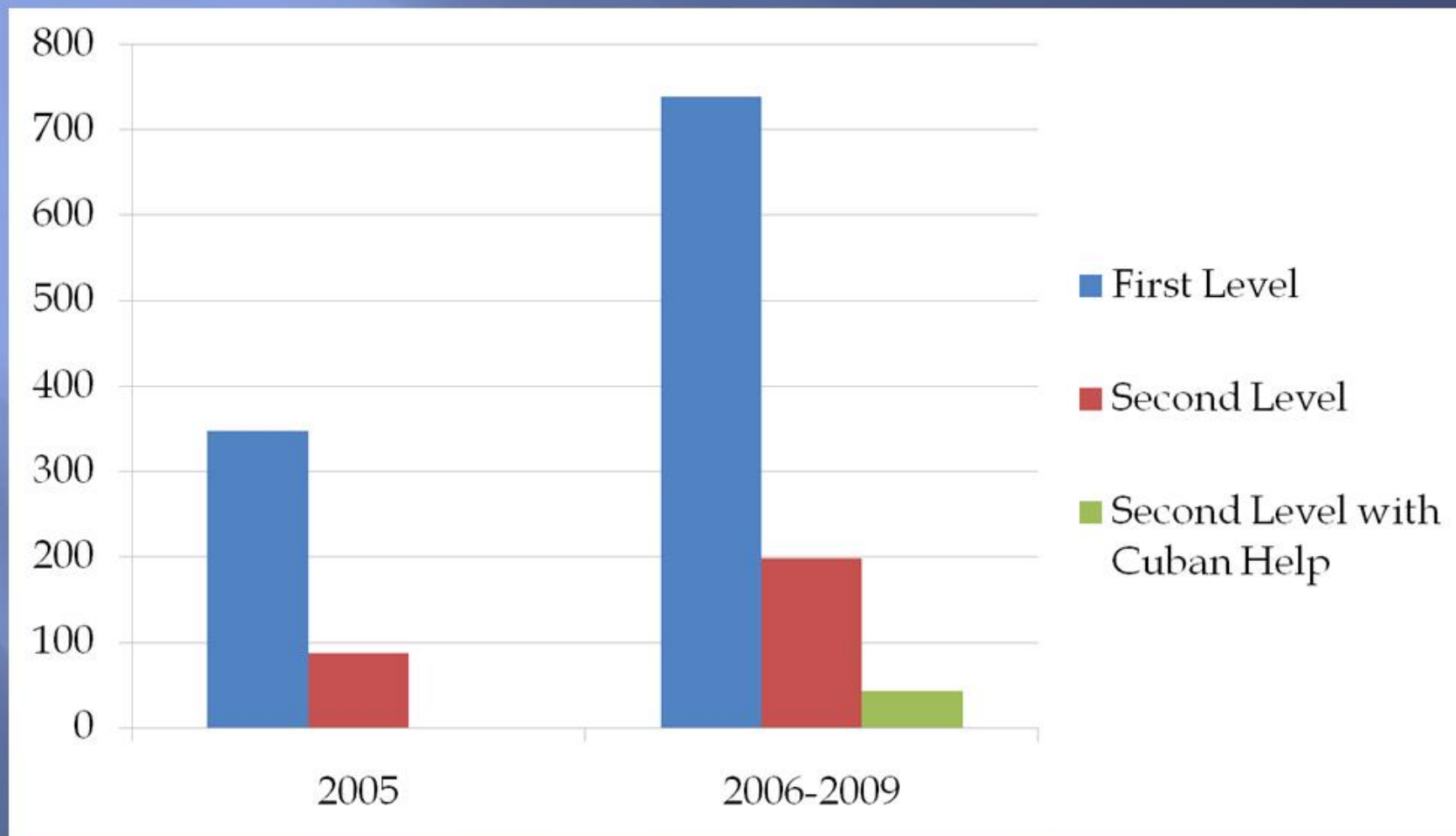

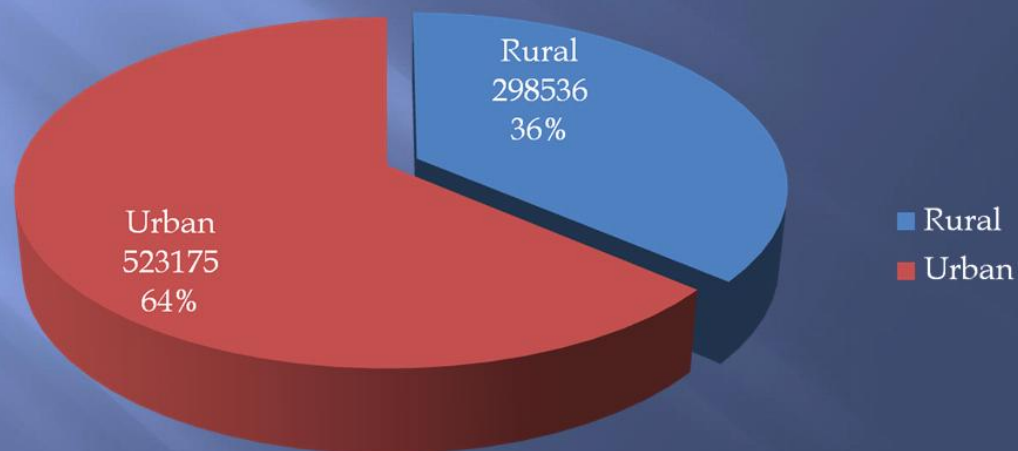


Number of Built Health Centers



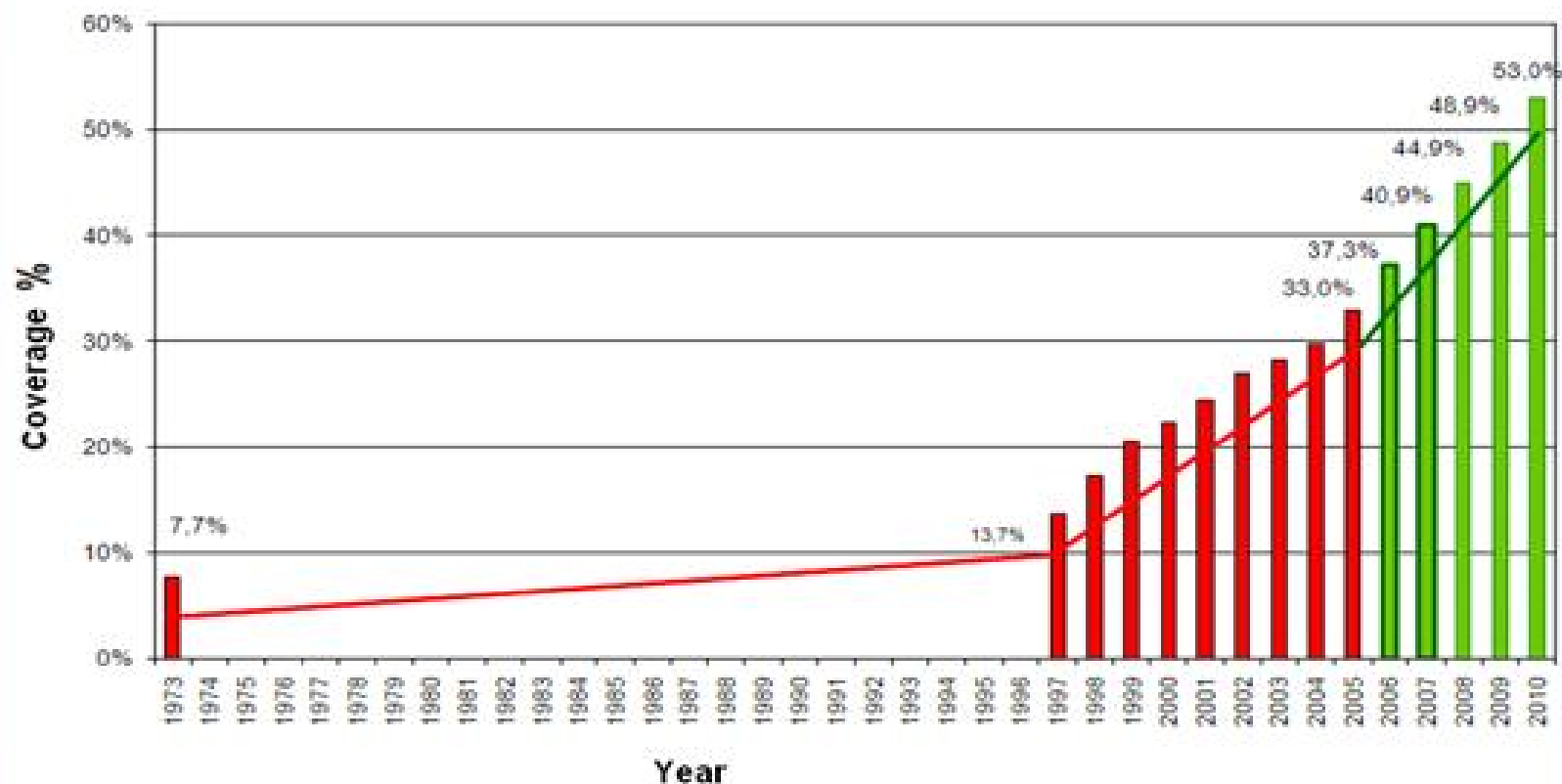

Coverage of potable water 2006 - 2009 (semestre)



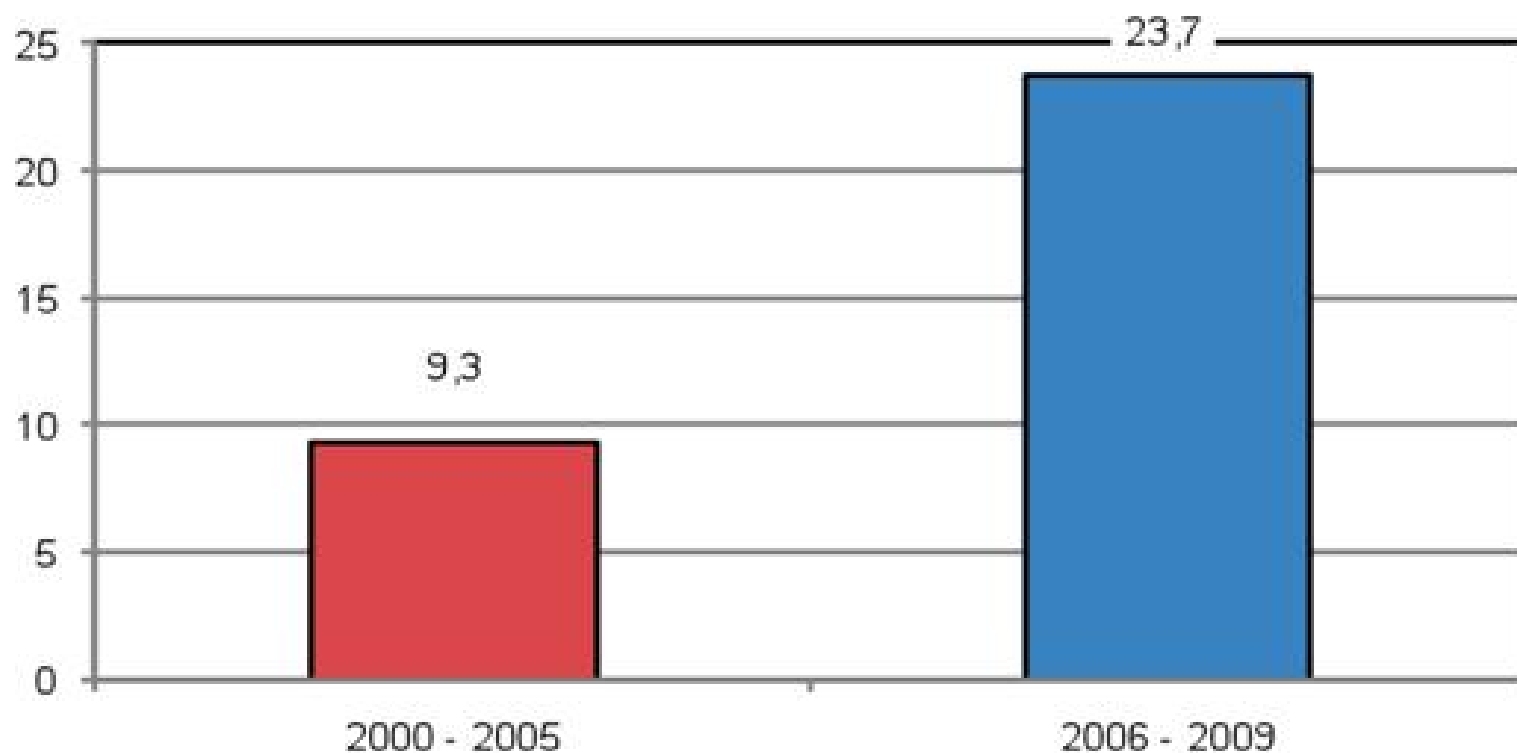

Electricity Coverage in rural areas (1976-2010)



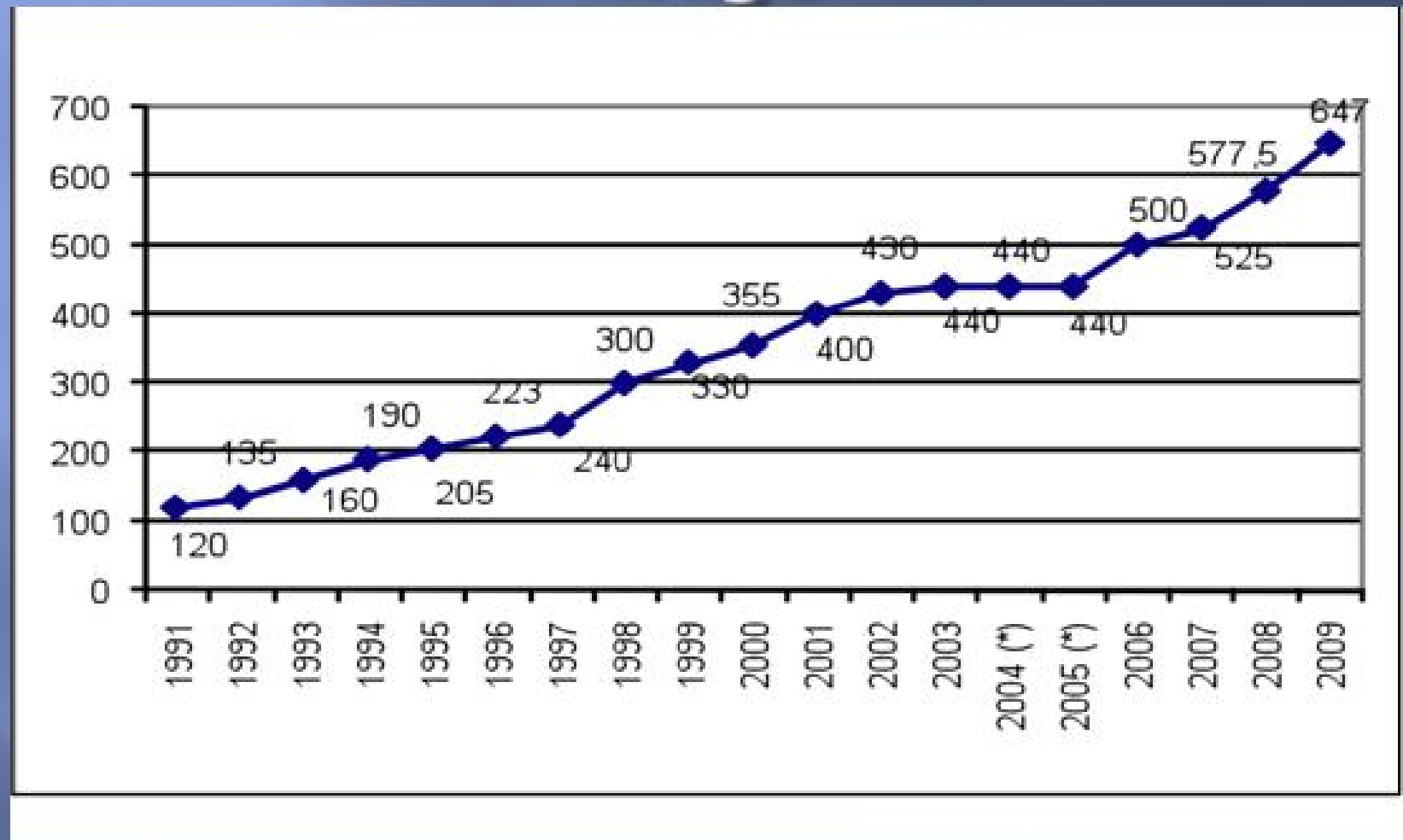

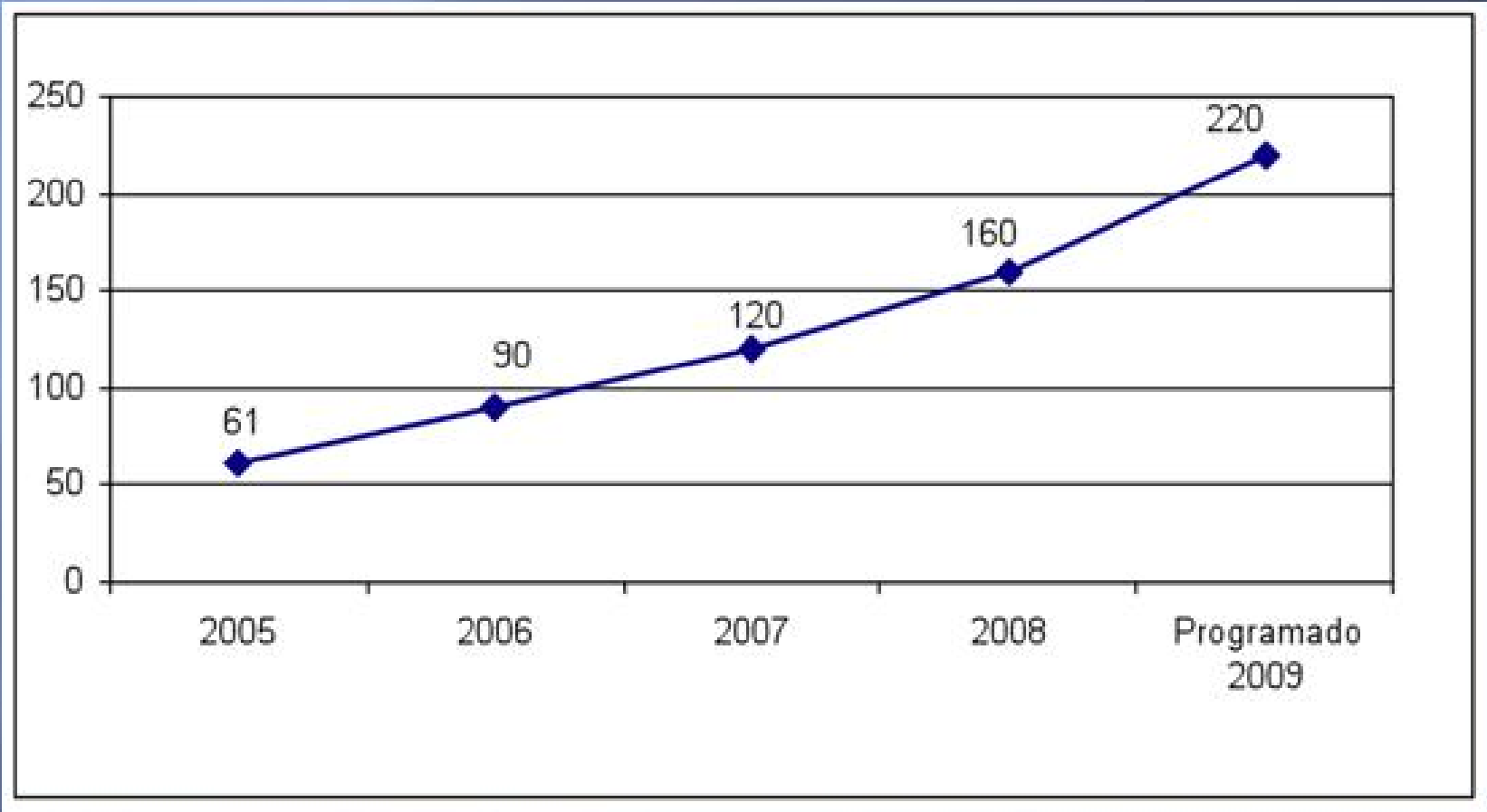

Set of laws to ensure job stability, promote safety, prohibit forced labor and to strengthen the labor unions

- ▣ **Increase of the minimum wage national:** Supreme Decree 29010 of January 1st, 2006; Supreme Decree 29473 of March 5th, 2008; Supreme Decree N° 0013 of February 19, 2009; Supreme Decree 0016 of February 19, 2009; Supreme Decree 0019-09 of May 4th, 2009.
- ▣ **Stability labor:** Supreme Decree 28699 of May 1st, 2006; Supreme Decree 29608 of June 18, 2008. **Security in the work:** Supreme Decree 0018-09 of May 4, 2009; Supreme Decree N° 0012 of February 19, 2009. **Prohibit the forced labor and analogous forms:** Supreme Decree 29802.
- ▣ **Strengthen the labor Unions:** Law 3352 of February 21, 2006; Supreme Decree 0016-09 of May 4, 2009.

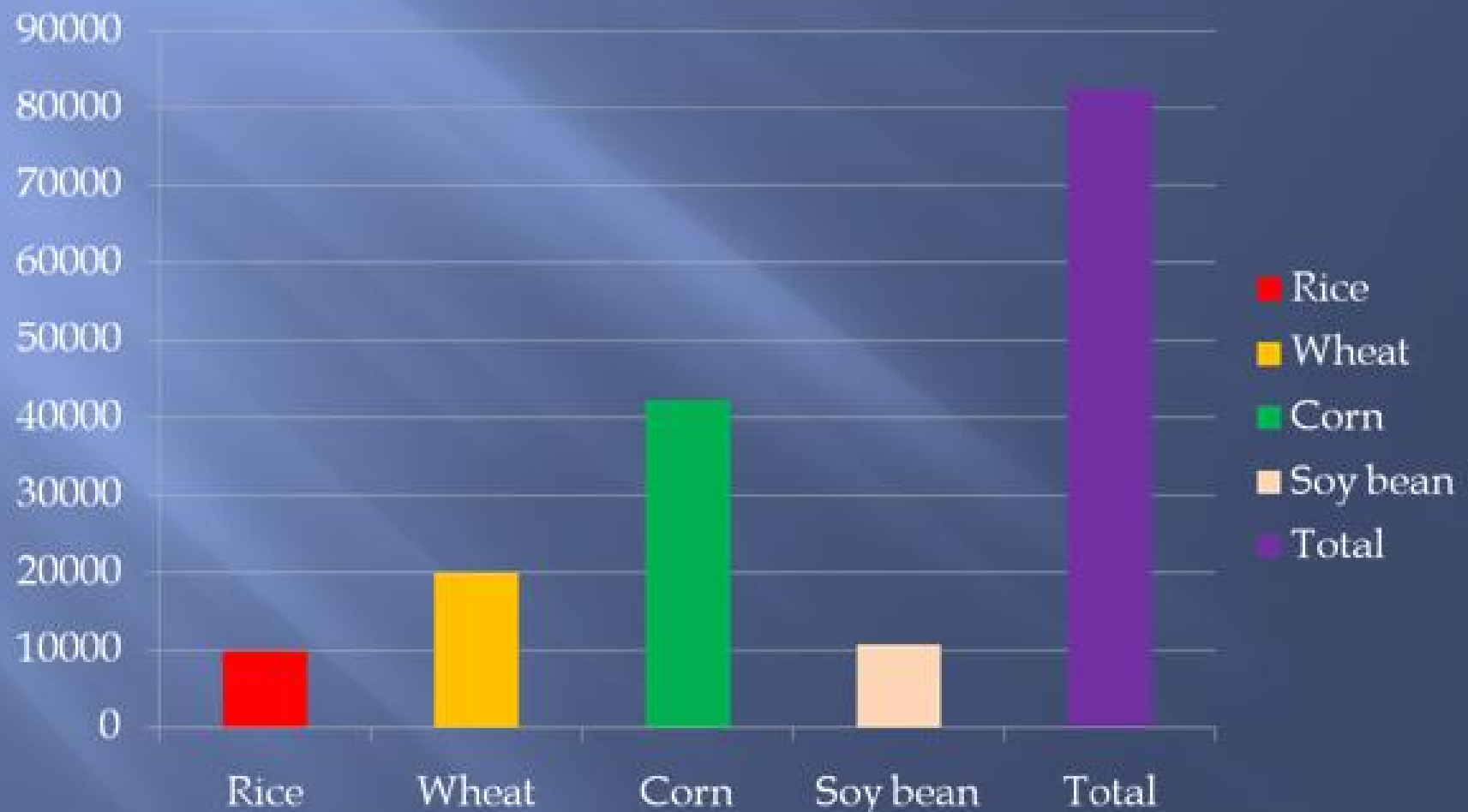

Installation of gas services at home



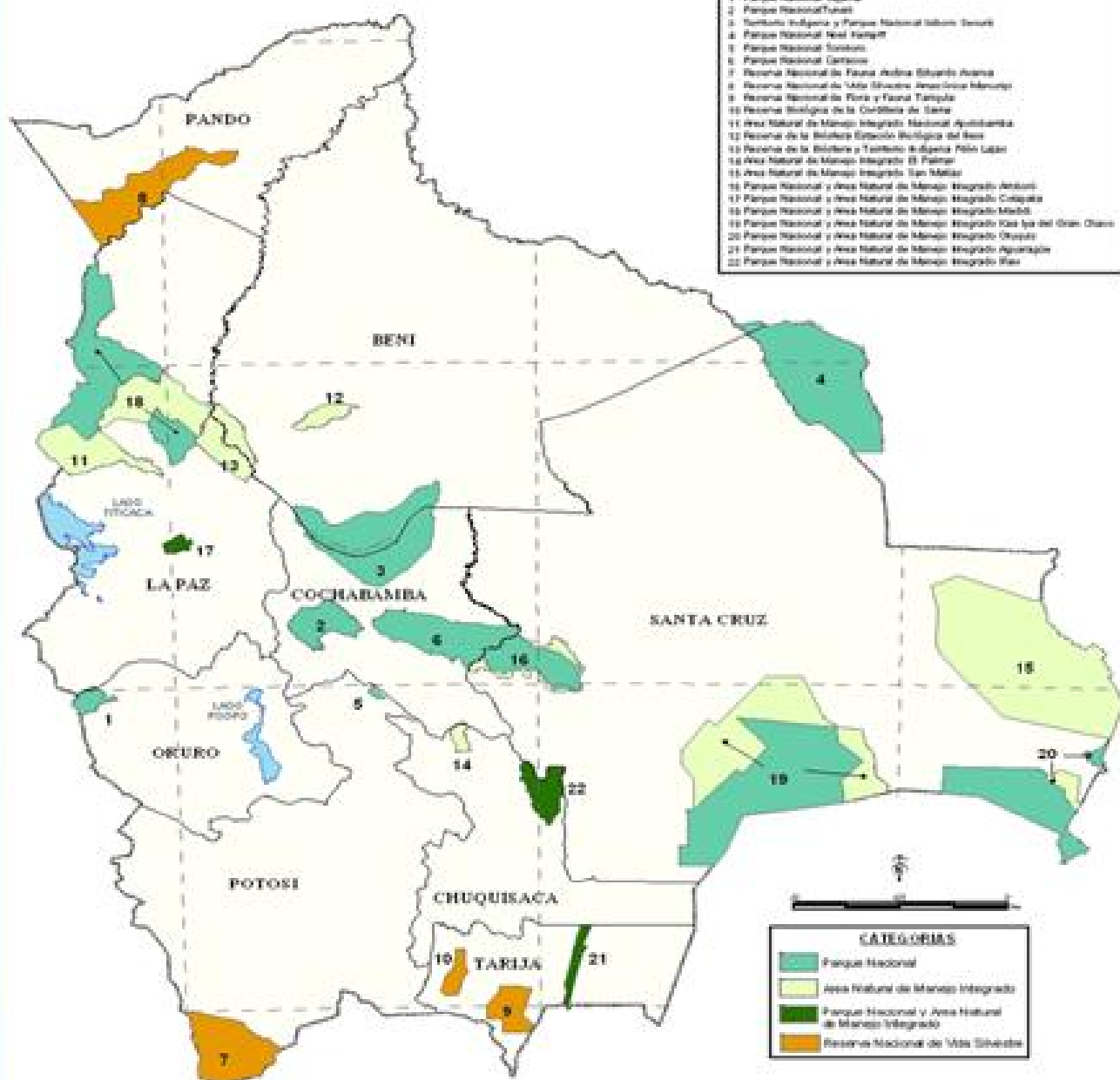

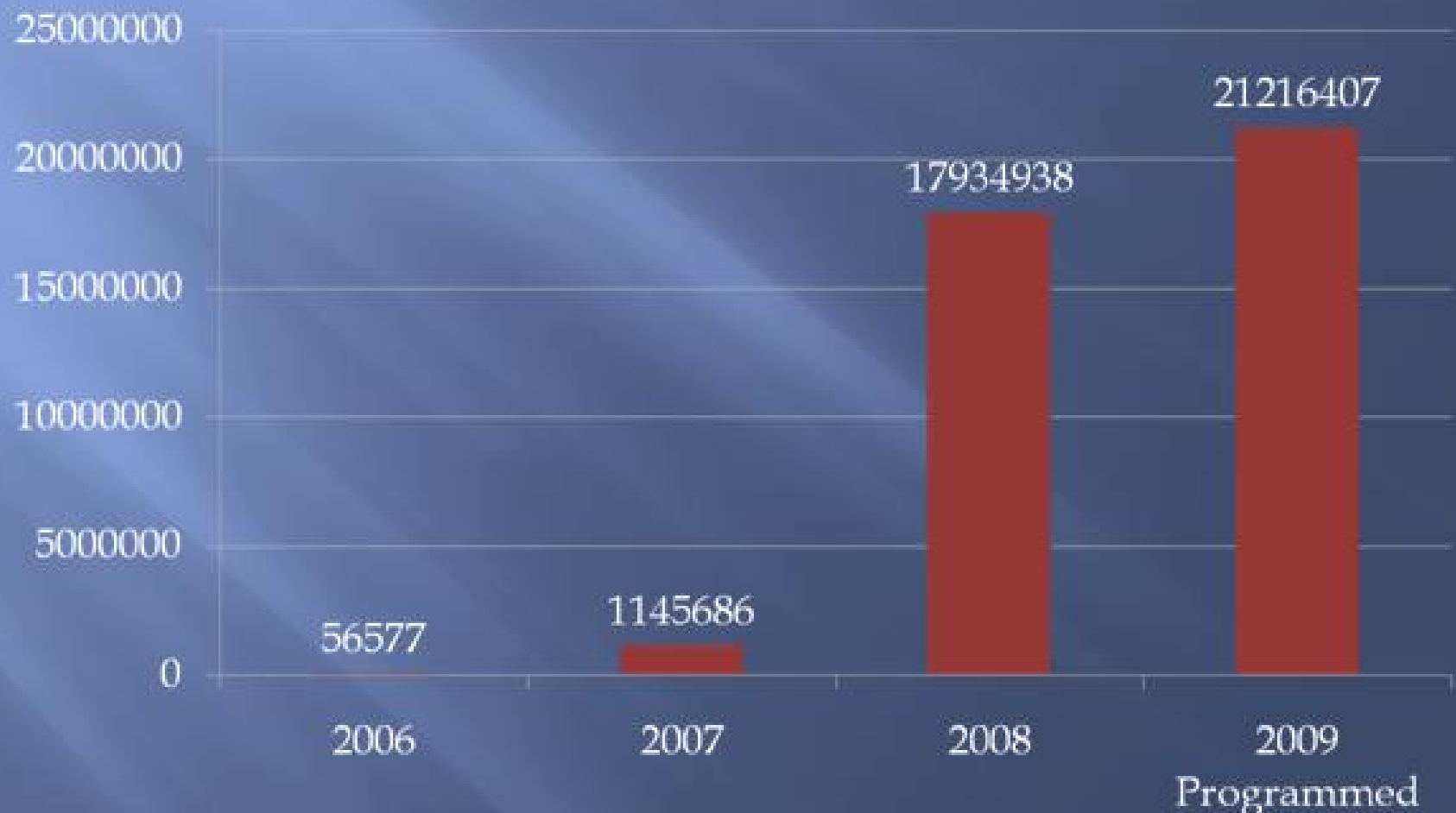

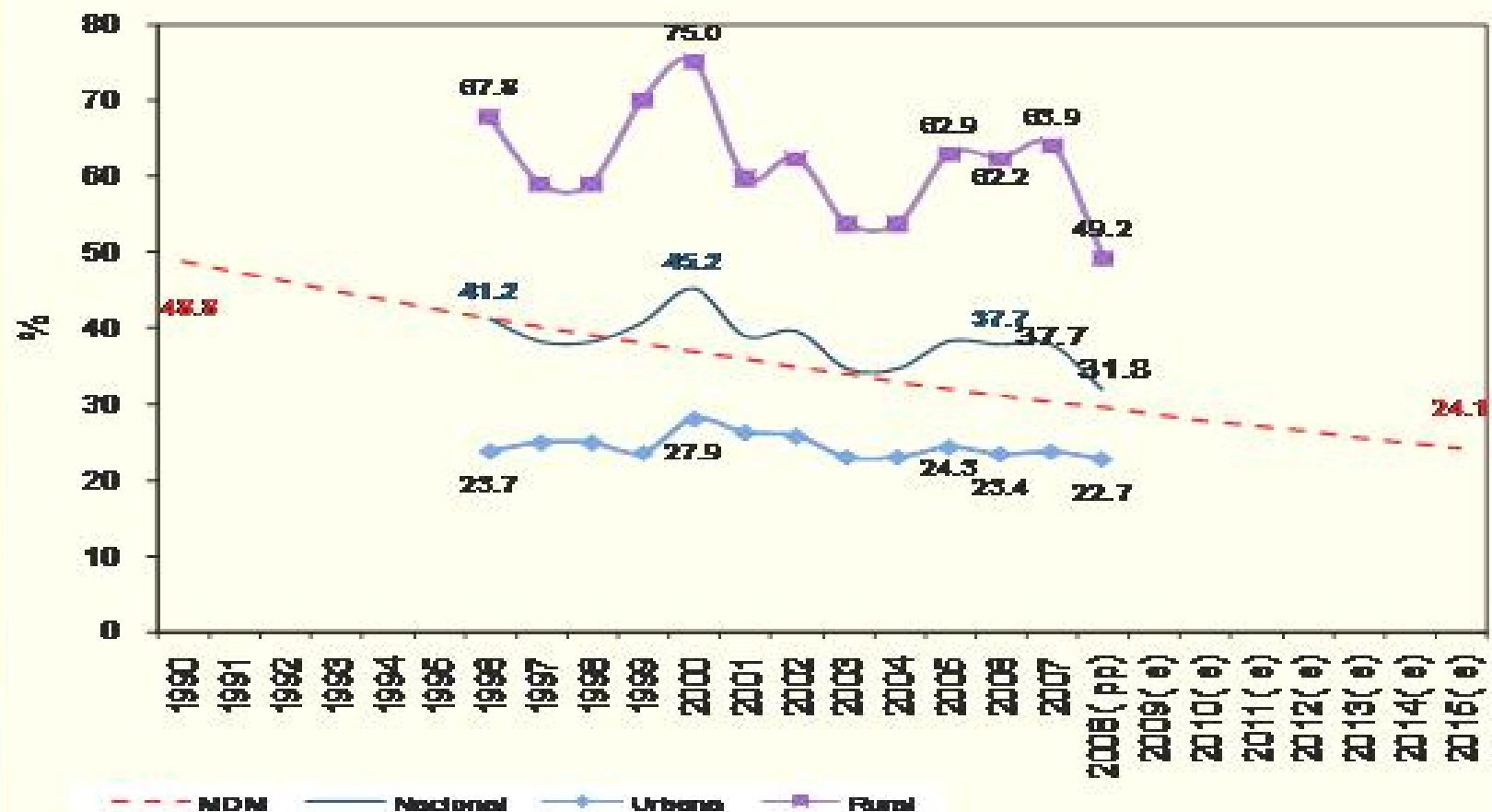

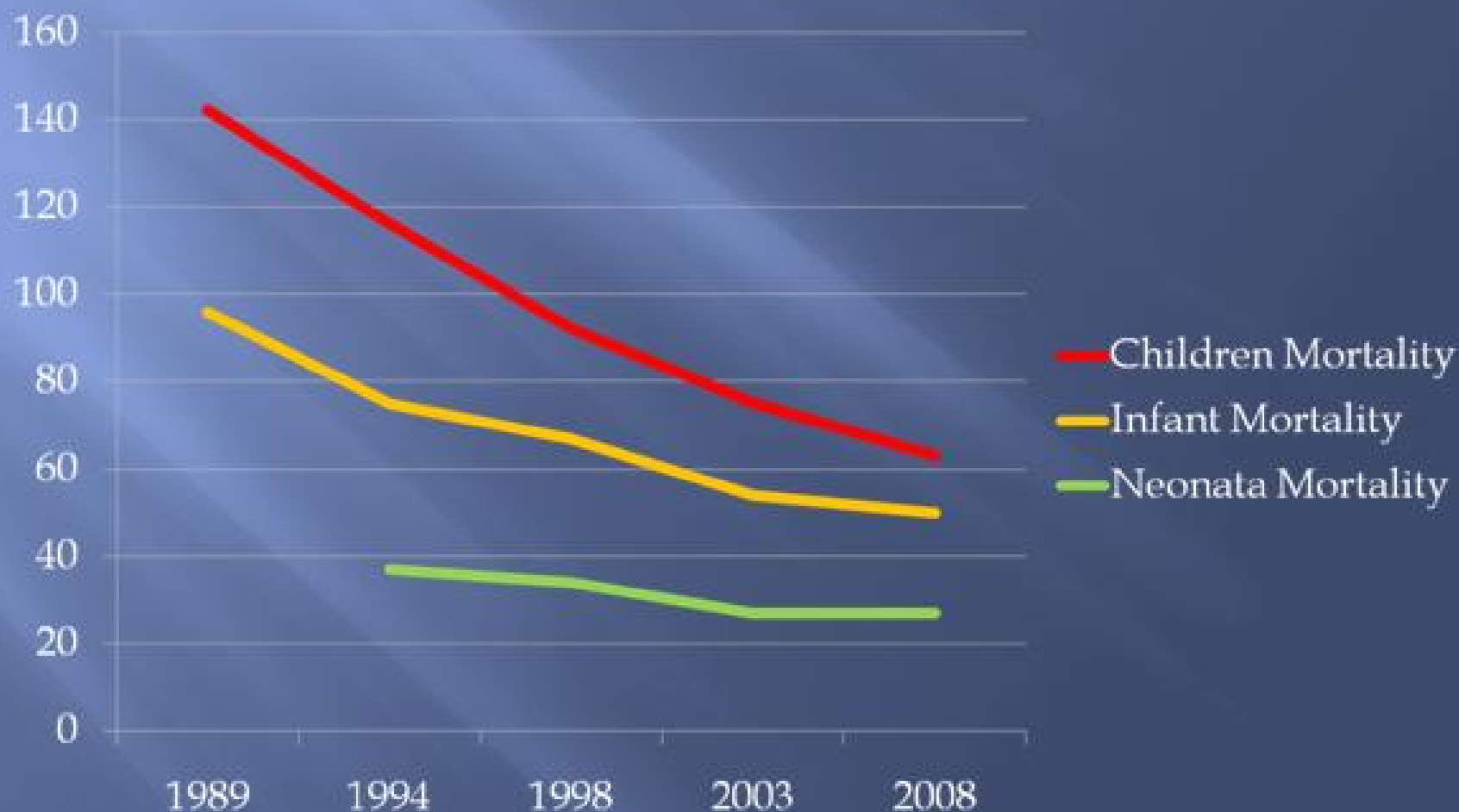

Prevalence and decrease of chronic malnutrition



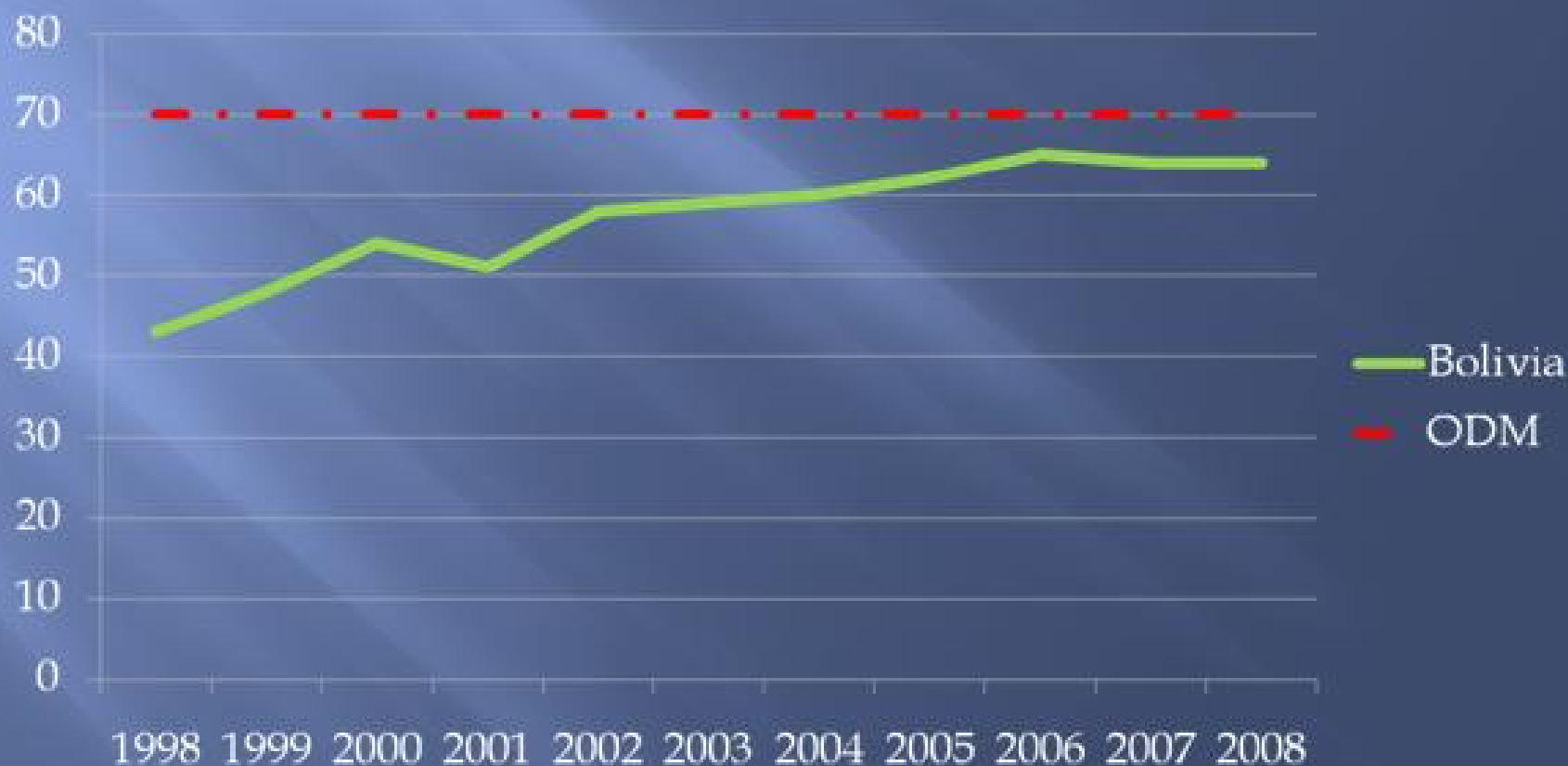
Neonatal mortality rates, infant and child according to demographic and health survey 1989, 1994, 1998, 2003, 2008
