Consideration of C-version

[Aide memoire:

Discussion part is prepared by substantive office (e.g. PPBD, OIOS, etc.). It is not discussed or approved by the Committee. The Committee only considers the **Conclusions and recommendations part**.]

First reading = general introductions

Introduction of the general idea of the language in one brief intervention. Delegations are encouraged to limit interventions to a brief explanation of overall intent, without addressing individual paragraphs.

- 1) Language proponent 1
- 2) Language proponent 2
- 3) ...

(in order of language submission)

Second reading = Consideration of specific proposals

- Consideration of each proposal individually (in case of alternative *proposals*, joint consideration is practice).
- Coordinator may encourage use of **Language support register** to indicate support specific proposals.
- Coordinator asks **“Are there any comments or questions?”**
- In the absence of comments or questions, coordinator asks **“Can we adopt?”**
- Proposals may be **adopted, amended, bracketed, “left aside”** for the moment, etc.

[Aide memoire:

- It is not the practice to give the floor to the proponent again to introduce the specific proposal
- In cases of disagreement, delegations may request to bracket a proposal.
- Alternatively, if further discussions are needed, delegations or the coordinator can propose to move on and come back to the proposal at a later time. It is neither customary nor necessary for a coordinator to bracket a proposal before moving on.]

Discussion of way forward

- Members are encouraged to continue discussions “offline”, as appropriate.
- The coordinator will liaise with the **Bureau** to be assigned an additional slot in the programme of work to conduct informal informals, if needed.
- In light of the liquidity measures currently in place, conference rooms are available during established meeting hours (10 AM - 1 PM and 3 PM - 6 PM).

Adoption of the draft report

[Aide memoire:

Depending on negotiations, adoption may proceed on the basis of the C-version (possibly Revs) or a negotiator's text/coordinator's proposal.]

Option 1: On the basis of C-version

1. Language is taken up paragraph by paragraph / modification by modification, with two options:
 - i. Adopt (as amended)
 - ii. Withdraw (original proponent to confirm)
2. Once nothing remains open: **Adoption of draft report as a whole**

Option 2: On the basis of a Negotiators' text

1. Language is taken up paragraph by paragraph / modification by modification
2. Before proceeding to adoption as a whole:
 - ➔ Coordinator confirms the understanding that all language proponents agree with foregoing C-version (and withdraw language that remains there)
3. **Adoption of draft report as a whole**
