59/547. Working Group to finalize the text of a United Nations declaration on human cloning

At its 76th plenary meeting, on 23 December 2004, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Sixth Committee,¹⁴³ took note of the decision of the Sixth Committee to establish a Working Group to finalize the text of a United Nations declaration on human cloning, on the basis of the draft resolution entitled "United Nations Declaration on Human Cloning",¹⁴⁴ and report to the Sixth Committee during the current session. The Working Group would meet on 14, 15 and 18 February 2005. The Sixth Committee would meet in the afternoon of 18 February to consider and take action on the report of the Working Group. The Working Group would be open to all States Members of the United Nations or members of specialized agencies or of the International Atomic Energy Agency. The Chairman of the Sixth Committee would be Chairman of the Working Group and members of the Bureau of the Sixth Committee would serve as Friends of the Chairman.
