

## 6. Decisions adopted on the reports of the Fifth Committee

### 66/554. United Nations Office for Partnerships

At its 93rd plenary meeting, on 24 December 2011, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Fifth Committee,<sup>126</sup> took note of the report of the Secretary-General on the United Nations Office for Partnerships.<sup>127</sup>

### 66/555. Capital master plan

At its 93rd plenary meeting, on 24 December 2011, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Fifth Committee,<sup>128</sup> authorized the continued utilization in 2012 of the unspent balance of the funding for associated costs approved in 2011 to allow the Secretary-General to continue the activities and projects planned for 2012, and decided to consider, at the first part of its resumed sixty-sixth session, the report of the Secretary-General on proposals for financing associated costs required for 2012 from within the approved budget for the capital master plan.<sup>129</sup>
