Thank you, Mr. Chairman.

Before the Committee today is a document that outlines the statement on the financial situation presented to the Committee on Tuesday, 11 October 2011.

I would like to draw the Committee's attention to paragraph 25 of the document in which it is noted that Hungary, Israel, Norway and Republic of Moldova have fully paid their dues and payable assessments since the cut-off date of 11 October 2011, joining the 19 other Member States in that position.

In addition, payments from Austria and Monaco also result in the addition of these two Member States to the list of Member States paying in full all their assessed contributions that are currently due and payable.
