At its 62nd plenary meeting, on 24 December 2012, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Fifth Committee,<sup>119</sup> having considered the report of the International Civil Service Commission for 2012,<sup>120</sup> requested the Commission to maintain the current New York post adjustment multiplier to 31 January 2013, with the understanding that the normal operation of the post adjustment system would resume on 1 February 2013.
