Situation of human rights in Myanmar Programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.3/67/L.49/Rev. 1 (A/C.5/67/14)

Statement by the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions to the Fifth Committee

(ACABQ report A/67/621)

Mr. Chairman,

The Advisory Committee's report (A/67/621) provides its recommendation on the statement submitted by the Secretary-General in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/C.3/67/L.49/Rev. 1 on the situation of human rights in Myanmar (A/C.5/67/14).

The Committee recommends that the Fifth Committee inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/C.3/67/L.49/Rev. 1, resources amounting to \$1,397,800 net (\$1,519,900 gross) would be required for the period from 1 January to 31 December 2013 for the continuation of the efforts of the good offices of the Secretary-General relating to the situation in Myanmar. The Committee draws the attention of the Fifth Committee to the fact that those requirements, which would be charged against the appropriation for 2013 for special political missions under section 3, Political affairs, of the programme budget for the biennium 2012-2013, have already been submitted to the General Assembly at its current session (see A/67/346/Add.1, para. 25-27), and the relevant observations and recommendations of the Committee are contained in its related report (A/67/604).
