Statement by Brazil

Mr. Chairman,

I wish to begin by thanking you for convening this meeting and for allowing my delegation to take the floor.

I also wish to thank Under-Secretary Takasu for his briefing to Member-States today on the financial situation of the United Nations.

As a founding member of this organization, Brazil remains committed to fulfilling its financial obligations to the UN budget. Brazil will continue to make all possible efforts to meet its financial obligations to the United Nations in a timely manner, and reiterates its full support and commitment to this Organization.
