Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons – United Nations Joint Investigative Mechanism

I am pleased to introduce the Advisory Committee's report on the Organization for the Prohibition of Chemical Weapons – United Nations Joint Investigative Mechanism (A/70/7/Add.17).

The Advisory Committee was informed that the Mechanism will work independently and report to the Security Council, through the Secretary-General, in accordance with the provisions of Security Council resolution 2235 (2015).

The Committee recommends approval of the proposed resource requirements for the Mechanism, apart from the requirements for one General Service position, at the G-6 level, in the New York office¹.
