One of the important outcomes in this session is the decision on the scales of assessments for the apportionment of the regular budget and PKO budget. While Member States varied on their positions for desirable outcomes on this matter, Japan highly welcomes that consensus was achieved on the scales of assessments for both regular budget and PKO budget. Here, Japan would like to renew its commitment to fulling its financial obligation in a faithful manner.

Madame Chair,

Going forward, the Committee must continue to review our working method of the Committee to conduct negotiations in a more efficient and effective manner.

Finally, Madame Chair, I wish you, the bureau members, representatives of the Secretariat and dear colleagues, a joyful Holiday Season and a Happy New Year.
