Mr Chairman,

I would like to update the Committee on developments since last week's briefing.

For the regular budget, the total number of Member States having paid in full for the regular budget remains at 131.

For peacekeeping operations, Azerbaijan, the Czech Republic and Kuwait have paid in full all peacekeeping assessments, which brings the total number of Member States having paid in full for peacekeeping operations to 40.

For the tribunals, Luxembourg has paid in full bringing the total number of Member States to 107.

Azerbaijan, Czech Republic and Kuwait are now also fully paid for all categories, bringing the total number of Member States to 38.

In addition, payments have been received from the following Member States:

For the regular budget, Argentina, Mexico and the United States.

For peacekeeping operations, Bahrain, Malaysia, Morocco, Spain and the Ukraine. Also, Switzerland has made a payment for one peacekeeping operation for the nonmandated period.

On behalf of the Secretary-General, I would like to thank these Member States for their positive action since last week's briefing on the UN financial situation.
