**Introduction of the Note of the Secretary-General
on the report of the Joint Inspection Unit entitled: “Enterprise risk management:
approaches and uses in United Nations system organizations” (A/75/718)**

Mr. Chair, Distinguished Delegates,

I am pleased to introduce, on behalf of the United Nations System Chief Executives Board for Coordination (CEB), the note of the Secretary-General conveying his comments and those of CEB members on the report of the Joint Inspection Unit “Enterprise risk management: approaches and uses in United Nations system organizations” as contained in A/75/718/Add.1.

Organizations of the United Nations system welcomed the relevance of the report to their Enterprise Risk Management (ERM) processes and supported the report’s findings, reaffirming their commitment to the existing reporting mechanisms for the implementation of JIU report recommendations.

Organizations noted that the JIU’s ERM benchmarks correlate to a dimension of the High Level Committee on Management Reference Maturity Model (RMM) for Risk Management, which provides organizations a roadmap for maturing ERM, as articulated in their response to Recommendation 2.
