Statement by Mr. Davit KNYAZYAN

Deputy Permanent Representative of Armenia to the United Nations

Mr. Chair,

At the outset, we would like to congratulate the newly elected Bureau and express confidence that under your leadership the Fifth Committee will successfully implement its mandate.
