Statement by H.E. Mr. KIMURA Tetsuya Ambassador of Japan to the United Nations

At the Main Part of the 76th Session of the Fifth Committee Organization of Work 4 October 2021

Mr. Chair,

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate you and all the bureau members on your election and to commend the Chair, Ambassador Mher Margaryan, for assuming this very important position. We are confident that you will guide this Committee towards a successful conclusion of our programme of work. I also wish to take this opportunity to thank Ambassador Carlos Amorín and the outgoing bureau members for their hard work during the 75th session. And as always, we are grateful to the Secretariat of the Fifth Committee led by Mr. Lionel Berridge for their efficient and professional work.

Mr. Chair,

In this main session, we have before us a number of pressing and complex agenda items, not only regular important agenda items such as the programme budget and special political missions, but also the scale of assessments.
