Statement by H.E. Mr. YAMANAKA Osamu Ambassador of Japan to the United Nations

At the Main Part of the 77th Session of the Fifth Committee Organization of Work 3 October 2022

Mr. Chair,

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate you, Ambassador Philippe Kridelka of Belgium, and all the bureau members on your elections to these very important positions. We are confident that you will guide this Committee towards a successful conclusion of our programme of work. I also wish to thank Ambassador Mher Margaryan and the outgoing bureau members for their hard work during the 76th session. And as always, we are grateful to the Secretariat of the Fifth Committee led by Mr. Lionel Berridge for their efficient and professional work.

Mr. Chair,
