BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE ON POTE SARASIN (THAILAND),
CHAIRMAN, FIFTH (ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY) COMMITTEE

Ambassador Pote Sarasin, who today was elected Chairman of the Fifth Committee, has been Thailand's Ambassador to the United States since 1952.

Mr. Sarasin was born on 25 March 1905 and called to the Bar of Thailand in 1928. From 1932 to 1945, he practiced at the Courts of Laws in Thailand and was a Member of Senate from 1948 to 1950.

Mr. Sarasin lectured at Chulalongkorn University and was Director and Honorary Treasurer of the Thai Red Cross. He was Deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs in 1948 and Minister of Foreign Affairs from 1949 to 1950.

He represented Thailand at the Third, Seventh, and Eighth Sessions of the United Nations General Assembly and was representative of Thailand to the United Nations Commission for the Unification and Rehabilitation of Korea.
