JIRI NOSEK, OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA

Chairman of the Fifth (Administrative and Budgetary)
Committee

Jiri Nosek, Deputy Foreign Minister of Czechoslovakia, who yesterday was elected Chairman of the General Assembly's Fifth (Administrative and Budgetary) Committee, has attended every session for the last twelve years.

In 1947, Mr. Nosek joined the Czechoslovak delegation to the second session of the General Assembly. He subsequently became alternate representative and attended all sessions of the Assembly through the tenth. Mr. Nosek was elected Chairman of the Second (Economic and Financial) Committee of the seventh General Assembly, Vice-Chairman of the Second Committee during the eighth session, and Chairman of the Third Committee during the ninth session. At the General Assembly's eleventh session Mr. Nosek served as Chairman of the Second (Economic and Financial) Committee. Mr. Nosek was First Vice-President of the Economic and Social Council in 1951 and 1952, and Second Vice-President in 1954. He has also represented Czechoslovakia on the Committee of Contributions.

Mr. Nosek was named Acting Permanent Representative to the United Nations in June 1950. In September 1953 he was appointed Permanent Representative until 1955 when he became Vice-Minister of Foreign Affairs of Czechoslovakia. In August 1956, he was sent to India as Czechoslovakia's Ambassador to that country.

Mr. Nosek was born in Cercany, Czechoslovakia in 1911 and studied at the School of Economic and Political Science in Prague, from which he was graduated in 1936.
