HENRIK AMNEUS (SWEDEN) ELECTED CHAIRMAN OF FIFTH
COMMITTEE (ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY)

Henrik Amneus, a Minister at the Permanent Mission of Sweden to the United Nations, today was elected Chairman of the Fifth Committee (Administrative and Budgetary).

From 1981 to 1986, Mr. Amneus served as a member of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (ACABQ) and as his country's representative on the Fifth Committee. He was Vice-Chairman of the Committee in 1983.

Mr. Amneus graduated from the Stockholm School of Economics in 1960.

After entering the Swedish Foreign Service in 1961, Mr. Amneus was assigned to his country's embassy in Brussels from 1962 to 1965, to the Swedish embassy in Baghdad from 1965 to 1967, and subsequently to the Swedish embassy in Bucharest.

From 1975 to 1978, he was posted to the Permanent Mission of Sweden to the United Nations in New York. During that period, he was a member of the Swedish delegation to the Governing Council of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP).

In 1978, Mr. Amneus was alternate representative on the Assembly's Fifth Committee. From 1978 to 1980, Mr. Amneus served as Counsellor at the Ministry for Foreign Affairs, Stockholm.
