Statement of H.E. Mr. Jan Kavan, President of the 57th Session of the General Assembly, on the murder of Ana Lindh, Foreign Minister of Sweden

I am deeply shocked and saddened by the murder of Ana Lindh, Foreign Minister of Sweden. Anna was a good friend and colleague with whom I had worked closely as Czech foreign minister and as President of the UN General Assembly.

I remember her as a warm and lovely human being, an excellent diplomat, a great European, a passionate social democrat and a wonderful woman with whom I shared her vision of a socially just and peaceful world based on solidarity and tolerance. I am appalled by this senseless and brutal death and hope that the perpetrator be speedily brought to justice.
