As you may know, the Thirteenth Session of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD XIII) will take place on 21 – 26 April 2012 in Doha, Qatar.

I am pleased to inform you that there will be an informal meeting to hear a briefing on the logistical and substantive preparations for the Conference. The meeting will take place on Friday, 10 February 2012, at 10 a.m. in Conference Room 1 of the North Lawn Building.

Following my introductory remarks, the briefing will be presented by Mr. Kobsak Chutikul, Special Adviser to the Secretary-General of the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development, and Mr. Richard Kozul-Wright, Head of the Unit on Economic Cooperation and Integration among Developing Countries.
