
Excellency,

The evaluation was mandated by United Nations General Assembly resolutions 62/208 and 64/289. In accordance with the agreed modalities, the process was overseen by a regionally balanced group of evaluation experts, the Evaluation Management Group, appointed by the United Nations Secretary-General.

The outcome of the evaluation is a major input into the up-coming deliberations of the quadrennial comprehensive policy review of operational activities for development. Member States may wish to consider conclusions, recommendations and lessons learned in the light of the debate on how to make the United Nations development system more relevant, coherent, effective and efficient.
