

The President of the General Assembly appointed us as Co-Facilitators to assist him in preparing a draft text of a concise outcome document, to be adopted at the high-level meeting on the rule of law as set out in resolution 66/102 adopted by the General Assembly on 9 December 2011. The high-level meeting will be held as a one-day plenary on Monday, 24 September 2012.

For this purpose, and as set out in resolution 66/102, we will convene informal consultations to enable sufficient consideration and agreement by Member States, which will begin with an open-ended informal meeting on 18 April 2012, from 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m., in Conference Room 3 of the North Lawn Building.

During this first meeting, delegations will have an opportunity to share general views on the outcome document to be adopted at the high-level meeting, as well as their views on the Report of the Secretary-General on the high-level meeting (A/66/749), submitted to the General Assembly pursuant to paragraph 18 of resolution 66/102.

We would appreciate your delegation's active participation, at the highest possible level, at this meeting and look forward to a productive and lively discussion on rule of law issues related to international law, peacebuilding and development.
