Excellency,

Resolution 66/124, adopted by the General Assembly on 19 December 2011, decided to convene a one-day High-Level Meeting, at the level of Heads of State and Government, on 23 September 2013 with the overarching theme “The way forward: a disability inclusive development agenda towards 2015 and beyond”.

In his letter of 24 May 2012, President of the 66th session of the General Assembly appointed H.E. Mr. Libran Cabactulan, Ambassador and Permanent representative of the Philippines to the United Nations and H.E. Mr. Fernando Arias, Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Spain to the United Nations as co-facilitators to undertake the needed consultations as envisaged in the mentioned resolution.

Pursuant to the resolution, the two co-facilitators convened the first round of consultations among Member States and other Stakeholders on the 10th and 14th September 2012 respectively.

In order to finalize all arrangements for the High-Level Meeting, I have decided to re-appoint the two co-facilitators. I am grateful to H.E. Mr. Libran Cabactulan and H.E. Mr. Fernando Arias for accepting this responsibility.

I very much hope that you will fully engage in this preparatory process so that we have a successful High-Level Meeting on this important subject of the realization of the MDGs for persons with disabilities.
