On 17 September 2012, the General Assembly adopted a resolution 66/294 on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly.

In this resolution, Member States decided to establish an ad hoc working group on the revitalization of the work of the General Assembly, open to all Member States, in order, “to identify further ways to enhance the role, authority, effectiveness and efficiency of the Assembly, inter alia, by building on the progress achieved in past sessions as well as on previous resolutions including evaluating the status of their implementation;” and “to submit a report thereon to the Assembly at its sixty-seventh session.”

I have the honour to inform you that I have appointed H.E. Mr. Mootaz Ahmadein Khalil, Permanent Representative of Egypt to chair this ad hoc working group.

I would like to thank Ambassador Khalil for accepting this responsibility and trust you will extend your full cooperation and support to him.
