Excellency,

Further, to my letter dated 28 February 2013 extending an invitation to Member States to be represented at the highest possible level at the high level meeting of the General Assembly on “the Appraisal of the Global Plan of Action to Combat Trafficking in Persons”, I wish to refer to the General Assembly resolution A/RES/67/260 adopted on 1 May 2013, which determined the modalities of the meeting.

I am pleased to inform you that pursuant to paragraph 10 of the resolution, I intend to request Ms. Mira Sorvino, UN Goodwill Ambassador against Human Trafficking and Ms. Alyse Nelson, President of Vital Voices Global Partnership to speak at the opening plenary meeting, in their capacities as eminent person and the representative from a non-governmental organization in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council respectively.

I intend to decide on the eminent person and the representative from a non-governmental organization no later than Wednesday 8 May 2013.

A detailed programme and other information on the high-level meeting will follow shortly, and will be available on the website of the President of the General Assembly.
