**Draft concept note**

**Introduction**

In accordance with General Assembly resolution 67/219, the General Assembly will hold a second High-level Dialogue on International Migration and Development on 3 and 4 October 2013. The same resolution invites the President of the General Assembly to organize a one-day informal interactive hearing with representatives of non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations and the private sector. The hearings will allow civil society to interact with Member States. A summary of the hearings will be made available to Member States prior to the High-level Dialogue. This note has been prepared in consultation with the 31-member civil society steering committee, established for the High-level Dialogue.

**Timing**

The informal interactive hearing will take place at the United Nations Headquarters in New York on Monday, 15 July 2013, from 10.00 a.m. to 6 p.m..

**Focus**

The informal interactive hearings will focus on the overall theme of the 2013 High-level Dialogue, which is to identify *concrete measures to strengthen coherence and cooperation at all levels, with a view to enhancing the benefits of international migration for migrants and countries alike and its important links to development, while reducing its negative implications.*

Specifically, the hearings will have the following thematic agenda: (a) labour and mobility; (b) rights and protection; (c) human development and diaspora action, and (d) migration, governance and partnerships. These four themes are closely linked to the four roundtables of the 2013 High-level Dialogue. As such, the thematic agenda for the informal interactive hearings allows for providing concrete and specific inputs to the roundtable discussions at the High-level Dialogue.

**Format**

The informal interactive hearings will consist of an opening session, four interactive panel sessions, an intermezzo featuring the voices of migrants “from the ground”, and concluding remarks.

The President of the General Assembly will preside over the hearings.

- The opening session will feature high-level officials of the United Nations and key note speakers.
- The first panel, focusing on migrant labour and mobility, will address issues such as regulation of the migrant labour recruitment industry, mechanisms to promote labour mobility, and labour rights of migrants.
- The second panel, focusing on migrant rights and protection, will pay particular attention to vulnerable groups such as migrants in crisis and transit situations as well as women and children participating in or otherwise affected by migration.
- The afternoon session will open with an intermezzo featuring voices of migrants “from the ground”, thus providing an opportunity for highlighting personal experiences to migration and development.
- The third panel, addressing human development and diaspora action, will discuss the integration of migration into national development policies and the post-2015 United Nations development agenda as well as the role of diaspora as entrepreneurs, social investors and policy advocates.
- The fourth panel, dealing with migration governance and partnerships, will discuss how international mechanisms and national implementation can improve partnership and coherence on migration.
- The closing session will feature concluding remarks by the President of the General Assembly.

At the beginning of each panel, the moderator will introduce the theme and the three panellists representing civil society and the private sector. The panellists will comment on the need for policies, actions and cooperation on migration in the next five years. Two representatives of Member States will respond to the proposals put forward by the panellists and pose questions to them. At the end of each panel, there will be an opportunity for short interventions from the floor by civil society and government representatives.

### **Selection of panellists and moderators**

The civil society steering committee will advise the President of the General Assembly on the selection of panellists, moderators and other speakers from civil society and the private sector. These speakers will be selected on the basis of their experience in migration policy, advocacy or programmes, and their representativeness of key civil society and migrant constituencies. Factors such as gender, geographic origin and sectoral representation will also be taken into account in selecting speakers.

Similarly, respondents from Member States will be selected with due regard to geographical balance, the country’s role in the global migration system, and the country’s engagement in particular theme of the panel.

### **Outcome**

The President of the General Assembly will prepare a succinct summary of the informal interactive hearings, highlighting main findings and key recommendations, and make the summary available to Member States prior to the High-level Dialogue.
