As you know, by a letter dated 17 October, the President of the General Assembly appointed us as Co-Facilitators to lead open, inclusive, and transparent consultations on the post-2015 development agenda, including the organization and modalities for the intergovernmental negotiations and the remaining issues related to the Summit for the adoption of the post-2015 development agenda.

In order to prepare for the above-mentioned consultations, we propose to hold a first meeting on 4 November to give an introductory preliminary briefing and to seek your views on the tasks ahead, both organizational and substantive, so as to facilitate a harmonized process going forward.
