On 11 September 2015, the General Assembly adopted resolution 69/321 on the Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly.

In this resolution, Member States decided to establish, at its seventieth session, an Ad Hoc Working Group on the Revitalization of the work of the General Assembly, open to all Member States, in order to identify further ways to enhance the role, authority, effectiveness and efficiency of the Assembly, inter alia, by building on the progress achieved in past sessions as well as on previous resolutions, including evaluating the status of their implementation and to submit a report thereon to the Assembly at its seventieth session.

I have the honour to inform you that I have reappointed H.E Mr. Vladimir Drobnyak, Permanent Representative of Croatia and H.E Mr. Wilfred I. Emvula, the Permanent Representative of Namibia, to serve as Co-Chairs of the Ad Hoc Working Group during the seventieth session.

I would like to thank Ambassador Drobnyak and Ambassador Emvula for accepting this important responsibility and trust that you will extend full support and cooperation to them.
