Ms. Katalin Bogyay, Permanent Representative of Hungary and Mr. Lukmon Isomatov, Head of the Department of External Economic Cooperation at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Tajikistan, Co-Moderators of the dialogue.

This first water dialogue will consist of a high level opening segment as well as two multi-stakeholders interactive Panel discussions, dedicated respectively to:

- The implementation of water-related SDGs: addressing challenges and seizing opportunities through strengthening cooperation and partnerships.
- Role of the United Nations system: improving the integration and coordination to support the Member States and other relevant stakeholders in the implementation and follow-up of water related SDGs.
