In order to start our discussions for Security Council Reform during this year and fulfill this mandate from the Pact for the Future, the Co-Chairs would like to invite delegations to a first informal meeting (“Back to Work”) to take stock of the progress achieved and discuss the work of the IGN during the 79<sup>th</sup> session on 22 October 2024 at 11.30-1.00 p.m. at the Permanent Mission of Kuwait 321 E 44th St, New York, NY 10017. In accordance with the practice of last year, the Co-Chairs have the honour to extend the invitation to these un-formal conversations at the **Ambassadorial / Chargé d’affaires level in a 1+1 format**. We kindly ask that you [RSVP](#) to no later than **Friday, 18 October**.
