**Report on Effective Measures to Enhance the Protection, Security and Safety
of Diplomatic and Consular Missions and Representatives**

1. Security Measures

- Collecting data and information, especially those activities involving international terrorism in the region and Cambodia.
- Forming intelligence secret service to protect the security of diplomatic and consular missions and Heads of diplomatic residences.
- Monitoring financial transaction operated in and out of Cambodia, especially at casinos and companies having only names but no business transaction activities.
- Ensuring the management of demographic data, facilitating the issuance of identity cards, the issuance of passports, the extension of visas, processing the requests for naturalization, and the issuance of residence books in order to contribute to reinforcing the country's security.

2. Protective Measures

- Deploying police forces to protect diplomatic and consular missions and UN offices at their requests.
- Providing security guards to protect diplomatic and consular missions 24 hours a day, including Heads of diplomatic residences.

3. Public Measures

- Promoting people's awareness of the terrorist activities, and enhancing the capability of the relevant competent authorities to take measures and actions to prevent them from occurring.
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
