The Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary General of the United Nations and with reference to Paragraph 12 of the General Assembly resolution 61/31 of 4 December 2006, has the honour to inform that the Government of Pakistan has taken following measures to ensure security of diplomats and diplomatic assets in Pakistan:

- i). Foreigners' Security Cells: Foreigners' Security Cells have been established in the Ministry of Interior and in all Provincial Home Departments to coordinate and ensure security of foreigners. Dedicated senior officers from both Federal and Provincial Governments are regularly monitoring and coordinating the security aspects;
- ii). Monitoring Mechanism: Monitoring Mechanism through Intelligence and Law Enforcement Agencies are firmly in place. Regular feedbacks on security loopholes are being received and corrective actions are being initiated;
- iii). Security at Office Precincts & Residences: Round-the-clock foolproof surveillance & security umbrella is provided by Law Enforcement Agencies & Intelligence Agencies where diplomats live, work or commute;
- iv). Security Escorts: Security Escorts are provided to diplomats moving out of Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT), when required/requested. Security cover is also provided in ICT on case-to-case basis;
- v). Diplomatic Enclave: Stringent entry/exit control system is in place for Diplomatic Enclave, which houses 24 embassies; and
- vi). Electronic Security: CCTV cameras have been installed in the Diplomatic Enclave and in other sensitive areas of Islamabad Capital Territory.

The Permanent Mission of Pakistan to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary General the assurances of its highest consideration.
