The report, annexed to the abovementioned Note, of the Permanent Representative of the Russian Federation to the United Nations dated 19 July 2006, contains information on violations of the security of diplomatic agents of the Russian Federation in 2006 and states, inter alia, that at the Russian Embassy in Turkey periodic telephone threats to commit terrorist acts have been reported.

The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Turkey to the United Nations would like to underline that from January 2005 until September 2006, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Turkey has not received any request from the Embassy of the Russian Federation in Ankara regarding such telephone threats.

The Permanent Mission of Turkey to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
