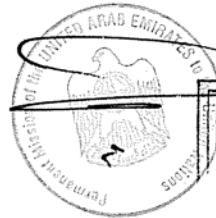
The Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, and has the honor to refer to the latter's note verbal No. LA/COD/4 dated 12 January, 2011, requesting information from the Government of the United Arab Emirates on its implementation of General Assembly resolution 65/30 of 6 December, 2010, entitled "consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular mission and representatives".

In this connection, the Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates is pleased to inform that the following measures are being taken by the UAE Government for the implementation of the above-mentioned resolution:

- 1- Arrangements are currently being made to install automated warning systems at all diplomatic missions and consulates, and hot lines are provided for their reporting of any threats that may affect their safety.
- 2- Patrols are in place for rapid intervention, and improvements are being made for rapid police responses to any emergencies situations.
- 3- In the event of any incidents threatening the safety of diplomatic missions and consulates, the information on these incidents are immediately passed to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs through the police departments concerned.

The Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates would appreciate the inclusion of the above-mentioned information in the report to be prepared by the Secretary-General for submission to the General Assembly at its sixty-seventh session.

The Permanent Representative of the United Arab Emirates to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations, the assurances of its highest consideration.
