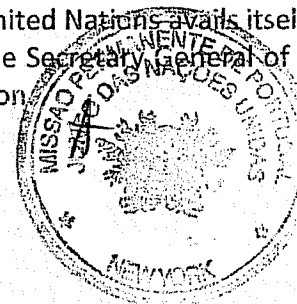

**Comments of Portugal concerning the implementation of the  
General Assembly Resolution 63/126, of 15 January 2009  
entitled**

**“Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and  
safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives”**

The Secretary-General of the United Nations has requested State Members to provide for information concerning the implementation of the General Assembly Resolution 63/126, of 15 January 2009, entitled “Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives”, namely paragraphs 10 and 12 thereof.

Regarding paragraph 10, Portugal informs that there are no recorded violations of neither the security or safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives nor the security or safety of missions and representatives with diplomatic status to international organizations.

In what concerns paragraph 12, the *Polícia de Segurança Pública* (Portuguese Police of Public Security) considers that the measures being adopted nationally have proven to be effective. Thus, currently there is no need to make any changes to those measures.
