Statement of the United States of America 70th General Assembly Sixth Committee Agenda Item 167 Report of the Committee on Relations with the Host Country Statement by Mark Simonoff, Minister Counselor for Legal Affairs November 16, 2015

The United States takes its role as host country seriously, and it takes all of its obligations under the Headquarters Agreement seriously, as well.
