The Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to paragraph 10 of the resolution A/RES/69/121 of 10 December 2014 entitled "Consideration of effective measures to enhance the protection, security and safety of diplomatic and consular missions and representatives", and submit the following information:

On 22 February 2015, in the city of Tripoli, Libya, an explosion went off in front of the official residence of the ambassador of the Islamic Republic of Iran resulting in physical damages to the building and property of the residence. The ambassador was not in Libya at the time of the bombing. The local police authorities were duly informed and they were present in the scene to protect the area from further attacks. Later that day, a terrorist group affiliated to Daesh in Libya claimed the responsibility for the attack. The embassy has been in touch with Libyan authorities to ensure that such attacks against its diplomatic premises would not be reoccurred.

The Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Secretary-General of the United Nations the assurances of its highest consideration.
